MARKET PLACE



HIGH STRFFT

In the High Street (From Verulam Road to the Peahen) the road has been closed except for timed Market Place. This has provided access. This has provided a benefit Street to create a traffic free to social distancing and supported opportunities for an outdoor economy including retail and street outdoor economy including retail cafes. In George Street (from High Street to Spicer Street) gates were put at the top and bottom of George environment to aid social distancing and support opportunities for an and street cafes.
