Aldbury Traffic Calming

The Highway Improvements Group (HIG) of Hertfordshire County Council (HCC) has been developing proposals, in liaison with Aldbury Parish Council, to enhance pedestrian safety in Aldbury village centre.

The primary aim of this Police and Crime Commissioner funded scheme is to improve pedestrian safety and accessibility by providing new traffic calming features in Aldbury. The scheme aims to alleviate current safety concerns for pedestrians and vulnerable road users, thus promoting sustainable travel.

The proposals can be viewed in greater detail on the drawing HC G-S1900.27 01 which is enclosed to this letter. The key components of the scheme are:

- New bands of granite setts on Station Road approaching the village centre;
- New courtesy crossing opposite the primary school entrance together with a kerb buildout of the footway adjacent to Memorial Hall; and
- New gateway features, entailing local carriageway narrowing on Station Road.
