Seeking your views on proposed parking restrictions at:

Pixmore Avenue (Broughton Hill) Letchworth Hertfordshire

Hertfordshire County Council (HCC) has been developing proposals to improve the safety of road users in Pixmore Avenue; County Councillor Michael Muir considers this scheme as a priority and is funding this through the Highway Locality Budget. For the purposes of the Public Engagement three specific sections of Pixmore Avenue are considered.

What is the proposal?

This element of the consultation focuses on the section of Pixmore Avenue between Broughton Hill and the southernmost junction of Wissen Drive. The key components for this location are the implementation of waiting restrictions and the establishment of a pedestrian refuge traffic island, shown on drawing HC_62254490_34_001_002_R0 (Broughton Hill).

What is the purpose of the proposal?

To prevent vehicles parking in such a manner that visibility and free flow passage of vehicles is increased at these locations and potentially a reduction of vehicle and pedestrian conflict at and away from junctions.

What happens next?

The public engagement exercise is the first part of a two stage process. The comments received from local residents and businesses will help us finalise our proposals prior to public consultation, or decide not to pursue them any further.

The second public consultation stage is open to anyone. An advertisement will be placed in the local newspaper. A site notice and plan will also be erected on lamp columns in the locality. It is intended that this will take place during **February / March 2019**

It should be recognised this process relates only to the traffic regulation order required for the parking restrictions and is not required for the establishment of the traffic islands and associated highway alterations.
