

Trade Union Facility Time

The total number of staff who are union representatives is 4, representing a full time equivalent of 3.

The total number of staff devoting at least 50% of their time to undertaking Trade Union Duties is 4, representing a full time equivalent of 3.

In total for the period 1st April 2015 to the 31st March 2016, the total working days spent on Trade Union activities was 37.26.

This equates to £3,673.10 annually or 0.002% of the annual pay bill. A further breakdown of the spending on each union is provided below:
