1. Decision

To agree that the HGGT IDP Update be published.

2. Reasons for the decision

Harlow-Gilston Garden Town (HGGT) is the name of a project to build 24,000 new homes and supporting infrastructure in and around Harlow, to deliver modal shift and sustainable travel corridors and to regenerate the town. HGGT is also the name of the partnership comprising East Herts District Council, Epping Forest District Council, Harlow Borough Council, Essex County Council and Herts County Council, who are working together to achieve the above objectives.

The partners have prepared an update to the HGGT Infrastructure Delivery Plan (IDP) which was initially published in 2019. This update was actioned to respond to changes in infrastructure costs as a result of recent inflation rises, to reflect the Gilston planning decision heads of terms and to remove contributions towards acute healthcare. This update was also to provide HGGT partners with a stronger negotiating position for other strategic sites (excluding Gilston).

The HGGT IDP Update was agreed for publication by HGGT Board on 12 September 2023.

3. Alternative options considered and rejected

The alternative option is not to publish the HGGT IDP Update. This option is not favoured because it would not support a strong negotiating position for HGGT partners with developers, nor the resolution of the HGGT Board on 12 September 2023. This would leave the partnership with no accurate or recent costings for infrastructure necessary to mitigate the impact of development coming forward in the HGGT area.
