1. Decision

To enter into a Delivery Agreement with Balfour Beatty for the construction phase of a new Eastern Transfer Station at Ware.

2. Reasons for the decision

Following the Secretary of State's refusal for the development of an Energy Recovery Facility at Hoddesdon, the need for a network of transfer stations has arisen. These transfer stations are required so Local Authority Collected Waste produced within the County can be bulked ready for transfer to disposal and processing facilities further afield.

Through the Scape Framework Balfour Beatty have delivered the transfer station preconstruction phase. Use of Balfour Beatty has ensured continuity with the design and construction team which built the Ware Recycling Centre. The transfer station will occupy the area to the rear of the Recycling centre and therefore continued provision of the design and construction team's knowledge and experience of this area during the construction phase will be valuable in building a fit for purpose facility, particularly as the development is located on an old landfill site.

3. Alternative options considered and rejected

Due to the location of disposal facilities out of county direct delivery of waste to these facilities is not viable and two attempts to construct a new in-county disposal facility have failed.

Other procurement routes for the construction of a transfer station have been explored, however, it was agreed to procure through the Scape framework to ensure procurement compliance and continuity of service from Balfour Beatty.
