1. Decision

1.1. The identity of the successful bidders and the value of the contracts awarded to them is included in Annex A which will be uploaded following the expiry of the conclusion of the call-in period/call in process.

2. Reasons for the decision

- 2.1. The procurement process was carried out for the provision of suppliers for the treatment of Scrap Metals Waste from Recycling Centres in Hertfordshire to assist the Council in carrying out its statutory function as a Waste Disposal Authority.
- 2.2. The county council has a single contract in place for the treatment and disposal of Scrap Metals wastes collected at Recycling Centres. The existing arrangements have a natural expiry in 2023 and options to extend are largely exhausted.

- 2.3. This Decision Record related to the procurement and award of contracts from 8 December 2023.
- 2.4. The market was approached to secure capacity; the procurement process was carried out with final tenders being submitted mid-October 2023.
- 2.5. One (1) bid was received from one (1) supplier.

3. Alternative options considered and rejected

- 3.1. The County Council is a Waste Disposal Authority responsible for arranging for the disposal of waste collected by Hertfordshire County Council at the network of recycling centres, under their duties and powers defined in the Environmental Protection Act 1990. Procurement of contracts for the collection and/or reception and treatment of these wastes is therefore necessary for the County Council to perform its statutory function as Waste Disposal Authority.
