# 3. Alternative options considered and rejected

The Council issued an Invitation to Tender following a Contract Notice being placed on the Government Contract Finder on 13th February 2025. Following a number of clarifications raised by bidders, and addressed by the Council, 76 tenders for lot 1 were submitted by the deadline of 27th March 2025.

Each tender bid was evaluated against a pre-disclosed robust set of evaluation criteria.

There were 54 successful tenders who achieved 50% or more when evaluated against the evaluation criteria.

The name of all tenderers and the results are set out in Annex A.
