Work Solutions helps people with mental health conditions, learning disabilities, Asperger's Syndrome, physical disabilities and sensory needs who are finding it difficult to find and stay in employment. We will help you to get into and stay in paid work by improving your confidence and self-esteem and talking to you and your employer about what is expected from you.

You can access the service if you are living in Hertfordshire and are known to Adult Care Services or Hertfordshire NHS Partnership Trust mental health services and are receiving Employment and Support Allowance or Universal Credit with limited capability.

We can help you to:

- Work out what skills, experience, talents and strengths you have by arranging short term unpaid work tasters
- Look and apply for the right job
- Contact and negotiate with employers

- Give advice and guidance on benefits and the impact of work on your finances
- Understand and resolve the issues relating to benefits or employment
- Prepare your CV, complete application forms and prepare for interviews
- Get funding for equipment, adjustments in your workplace or travel to work through the Access to Work scheme
- Learn the job and settle into the role with support in the workplace if needed, until you and your employer are happy with your work
- Support you and your employer for as long as needed

If required, we can arrange a signer / interpreter to support you.
