Foster carers are urgently needed in Hertfordshire

Hertfordshire County Council runs a non-profit fostering service dedicated to providing children and young people with a safe and nurturing environment during times of need. In Hertfordshire, there are approximately 1,000 children in care and more than 400 households fostering with their local council.

But the numbers of foster carers are declining, both locally and nationally. The council urgently needs more people to become foster carers, to make a difference to the lives of local children.

Could you provide stability, care and a family home for a local child?

You'll receive training and support and, as a foster carer, you'll receive a weekly payment for your skills, plus a weekly allowance for each child you look after.
