

Guest Speaker: **Charlotte Skene Catling, Skene Catling de la Peña architects**



Charlotte Skene Catling co-founded Skene Catling de la Peña architects in 2003. She has written about architecture, design and fashion and has contributed to the Sunday Telegraph, The Burlington Magazine, The Architectural Review and ARCH+. She runs projects that border architecture and other disciplines such as film and music in parallel to her practice.

Charlotte taught a post-graduate architecture unit at the Royal College of Art between 2007 and 2012, advised as a consultant in the formation of the London School of Architecture (LSA), and is completing a research project with the photography department of the Royal College of Art and the Rothschild Foundation focused on representation in architecture. She is external examiner for the

University of Greenwich and currently teaches at the Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT) in Germany.
