#### **Notice of application to register common land at Bury Wood, Hemel Hempstead**

An application has been made on 26<sup>th</sup> December 2020 to Hertfordshire County Council as Commons Registration Authority for Hertfordshire by the Open Spaces Society to amend the register of common land by registering land south of Sheethanger Common and east of Bury Rise, known as Bury Wood in the area of Hemel Hempstead and shaded green on the attached plan. The application states that the land was provisionally registered as common land as part of Shothanger (Sheethanger) Common under the Commons Registration Act 1965 (provisional registration number CL078), but cancelled by agreement, and is eligible for re-registration as waste land of a manor.

A copy of the application, which includes a plan of the land affected and supporting evidence, is available for inspection at County Hall and may be seen free of charge at Front Reception, County Hall, Hertford, SG13 8DN between 9.00 am to 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday.
