- to remove from the Register land registered as common land known as Top Field which comprises the football ground located at the junction of Fishponds Road and Bedford Road, Hitchin and forming part of Cow Common.

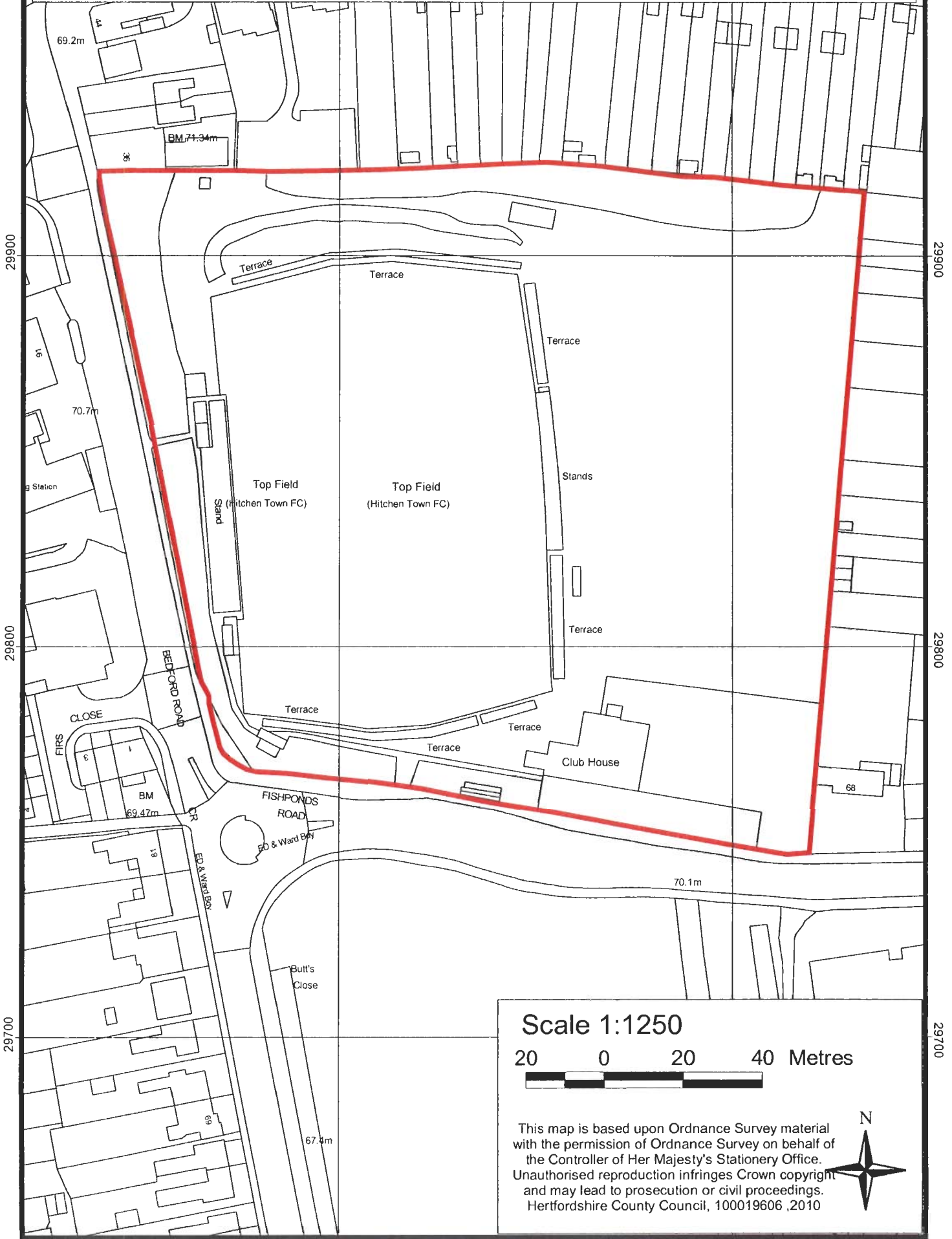

The representation must state your name and postal address, the nature of your interest in the land, the grounds on which your representation is made and must be signed by you.
