

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION
OF MODIFICATION ORDER

Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Definitive Map and Statement of Public
Rights of Way in Hertfordshire

**The Hertfordshire County Council (Aldenham 5, 27 and 72)
Modification Order 2012**

The above named Order, made on 26 September 2012, was confirmed with modifications by an Inspector acting for the Secretary of State for the Environment on 7 February 2014.

This order will divert the public footpath Aldenham 5 from its junction with Oakridge Lane (point E on the Order Plan), generally north east to its junction with Aldenham bridleway 72 (point D on the Order Plan). This order will also divert part of Aldenham FP27 from its junction with Aldenham BR72 and the private access road to Hill Farm (point B on the Order Plan) in a generally south easterly direction to its junction with Aldenham BR27 and Oakridge Lane (point C on the Order Plan). This order will also divert part of Aldenham BR72 commencing from the junction of a farm track north of Hill Farm (point A on the Order Plan) generally south (passing its junctions with the northern end of Aldenham FP27 and with Aldenham FP5) to its junction with Aldenham FP27 and Oakridge Lane (point C on the Order Plan), as shown on the Order Plan.

A copy of the confirmed Order may be seen free of charge at Front Reception of Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford, from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday and can be bought from Hertfordshire County Council at a cost of £2. A copy of the confirmed Order and Notice may also be seen at Hertsmere Borough Council Offices, Elstree Way, Borehamwood, Herts, WD6 1WA.

The Order becomes operative from the date on which following its confirmation, Hertfordshire County Council confirms in writing that the Works described in an Agreement dated 7 September 2012 between the County Council and Michael Patrick Stearns and Elizabeth Jane Elford Stearns, made under Section 119(5) of the 1980 Act, have been completed to its satisfaction. But if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, or any regulation made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may, under paragraph 12 of Schedule 15 of the Act within 42 days from 6th March 2014, make application for the purpose of the High Court.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Hertfordshire County Council (Aldenham 5, 27 and 72) Public Path Diversion Order 2012

This Order is made by Hertfordshire County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners lessees and occupiers of the land crossed by the footpaths and bridleway described in paragraph 1 of the order it is expedient that the lines of the paths and the way should be diverted.

Michael Patrick Stearns and Elizabeth Jane Elford Stearns have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new sites of the paths and the way into a fit condition for use by the public.

Hertsmere Borough Council has been consulted in the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

this Order comes into effect, which will be the date on which, following its confirmation, Hertfordshire County Council confirms in writing that the Works described in an Agreement dated 7 September 2012 between the County Council and Michael Patrick Stearns and Elizabeth Jane Elford Stearns, made under Section 119(5) of the 1980 Act, have been completed to its satisfaction.

BY THIS ORDER

1. The public rights of way over the land situate at Aldenham shown by continuous bold lines on the plan forming part of this Order ("the Order Plan") and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be stopped up on the date of ~~confirmation of this Order~~.
2. Notwithstanding this Order Arqiva Services Ltd shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1, namely all such rights in respect of any apparatus belonging to them on under or over the said land.
3. There shall on the date of ~~confirmation of this Order~~ *this Order comes into effect* be public footpaths and a public bridleway over the land situate at Aldenham described in Part 2 of the Schedule. The footpaths and bridleway are shown by a bold broken line on the Order Plan.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS AND WAY

The full width of Aldenham FP5 commencing at TL 1511 0038 (Point E on the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 380 metres to its junction with Aldenham BR72 at TL 1524 0073 (Point D on the Order Plan)

The full width of part of Aldenham FP27 commencing at TL 1518 0084 (Point B on the Order Plan) at its junction with Aldenham BR72 and the private access road to Hill Farm, Watling Street, Radlett and continuing in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 160 metres to its junction with Aldenham BR72 and Oakridge Lane at TL 1528 0071 (Point C on the Order Plan)

The full width of part of Aldenham BR72 commencing at TL 1521 0101 (Point A on the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally southerly direction for approximately 405 metres (passing its junctions with the northern end of Aldenham FP27 and with Aldenham FP5) to its junction with Aldenham FP27 and Oakridge Lane at TL 1528 0071 (Point C on the Order Plan)

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATHS AND WAYS

A public footpath commencing at Aldenham BR5 and Oakridge Lane at TL 1512 0038 (Point F on the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally north easterly direction on the east side of Oakridge Lane along field headland and through a copse for a distance of approximately 360 metres to a junction with Oakridge Lane at TL 1529 0070 (Point G on the Order Plan)

Width: 2.5 metres

A public footpath commencing at a junction with the new route of Aldenham BR72 and the private access road to Hill Farm, at TL 1523 0087 (Point H on the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally south easterly direction along the eastern side and running parallel to the new route of Aldenham BR72 for approximately 170 metres to a junction with Oakridge Lane at TL 1529 0071 (Point C1 on the Order Plan)

Width: 2 metres

A public bridleway commencing at TL 1521 0101 (Point A on the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally southerly direction along a track for a distance of approximately 140 metres and crossing the private access road to Hill Farm, to a junction with the new route of Aldenham FP27 at TL 1523 0087 (Point H on the Order Plan) and then continuing in a generally south easterly direction along the western side and running parallel to the new route of part of Aldenham FP27 for approximately 170 metres to a junction with Oakridge Lane at TL 1529 0071 (Point C1 on the Order Plan)

Width: 4 metres



