

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

**Hertfordshire County Council
(Aspenden 11 & Buntingford 44)
Diversion Order 2018**

This Order is made by Hertfordshire County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the bridleway described in paragraph 1 of this Order and the public it is expedient that the line of the way should be diverted.

Hertfordshire County Council has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the way into a fit condition for use by the public.

East Herts District Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Aspenden and Buntingford and shown by a bold continuous line on the plan contained in this Order ("the Order Plan") and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 90 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 90 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public bridleway over the land situate at Aspenden described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Order Plan.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

**PART 1
DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY**

The full width of that part of Aspenden Bridleway 11 and all of Buntingford Bridleway 44 from the A10 Buntingford Bypass at TL 3603 2852 (point H on the Order Plan) continuing east through the Watermill Industrial Estate for approximately 290 metres to join the Aspenden Road (public highway) at TL 3632 2854 (point G on the Order Plan).

Width: 4 metres between TL 3603 2852 (point H on the Order Plan) to TL3619 2853 (point F on the Order Plan)

4 feet (1.2m) between TL 3619 2853 (point F on the Order Plan) to TL 3632 2854 (point G on the Order Plan)

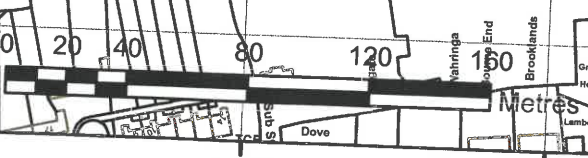

**PART 2
DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY**

A public bridleway commencing from the south west side of the A10 Buntingford Bypass at TL 3603 2852 (point H on the Order Plan) and then running generally south east on the south west side of the boundary along the field edge for approximately 240 metres to TL 3624 2840 (point I on the Order Plan) then slanting away from the boundary for approximately 25 metres to join the Aspenden Road (public highway) approximately 10 metres from the field boundary at TL 3626 2839 (point J on the Order Plan).

Width: 4 metres between TL 3603 2852 (point H on the Order Plan) to TL3626 2839 (point J on the Order Plan)
