OF MODIFICATION ORDER

Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

Definitive Map and Statement of Public

**The Hertfordshire County Council (Baldock 43)
Modification Order 2014**

The above named Order, made on 31st January 2014, was confirmed without modification by Hertfordshire County Council on 4th April 2014.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement by adding the footpath running from Chilvers Bank public highway at TL 2423 3325 continuing north, north west for 60 metres following the access between house numbers 12 and 14 Chilvers Bank and joining Bridleway 39 at TL 2421 3330.

A copy of the confirmed Order may be seen free of charge at Front Reception of Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford, from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday and can be bought from Hertfordshire County Council at a cost of £2. A copy of the confirmed Order and Notice may also be seen at North Herts District Council, Council Offices, Gernon Road, Letchworth Garden City, SG6 3JF.

The Order becomes operative as from the date on which it was confirmed, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, or any regulation made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may, under paragraph 12 of Schedule 15 of the Act within 42 days from 17th April 2014, make application for the purpose of the High Court.

This Order is made by Hertfordshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Hertfordshire require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3) (c)(i) and (iii) of the Act, namely the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that (i) a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic; and (iii) the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. Hertfordshire County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 20th January 2014.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Hertfordshire shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the plan attached to the Order ("the Order Plan").
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Hertfordshire County Council (Baldock 43) Modification Order 2014.

Width: 2.6 metres between TL 2423 3325 (point A on the Order Plan) and TL 2422 3329 (point B on the Order Plan)

3 metres between TL 2422 3329 (point B on the Order Plan) and TL 2421 3330 (point C on the Order Plan)
