

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF A DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

**HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BARLEY 15)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2013**

On 16th May 2014, Hertfordshire County Council confirmed the above Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public footpath running from TL 4113 3755 east for 160 metres to Barley 16 at TL 4128 3755, onto a new line from TL 4113 3755 south south east for 90 metres to Barley 16 at TL 4117 3747, as shown on the Order Plan.

A copy of the order and the order plan may be seen free of charge at front reception of Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford, from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday and at North Hertfordshire District Council, Gernon Road, Letchworth Garden City, SG6 3JF. Copies of the order and plan may be bought from Hertfordshire County Council at the price of £2.

The Order comes into force as from 29th May 2014, but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 29th May 2014, make an application to the High Court.

This Order is made by Hertfordshire County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Mr R D Hamilton Russell has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

North Hertfordshire District Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1 The public right of way over the land situated at Barley and shown by a bold continuous line on the Plan forming part of this Order ("the Order Plan") and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this Order.

- 2 There shall on the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Barley and described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Order Plan.

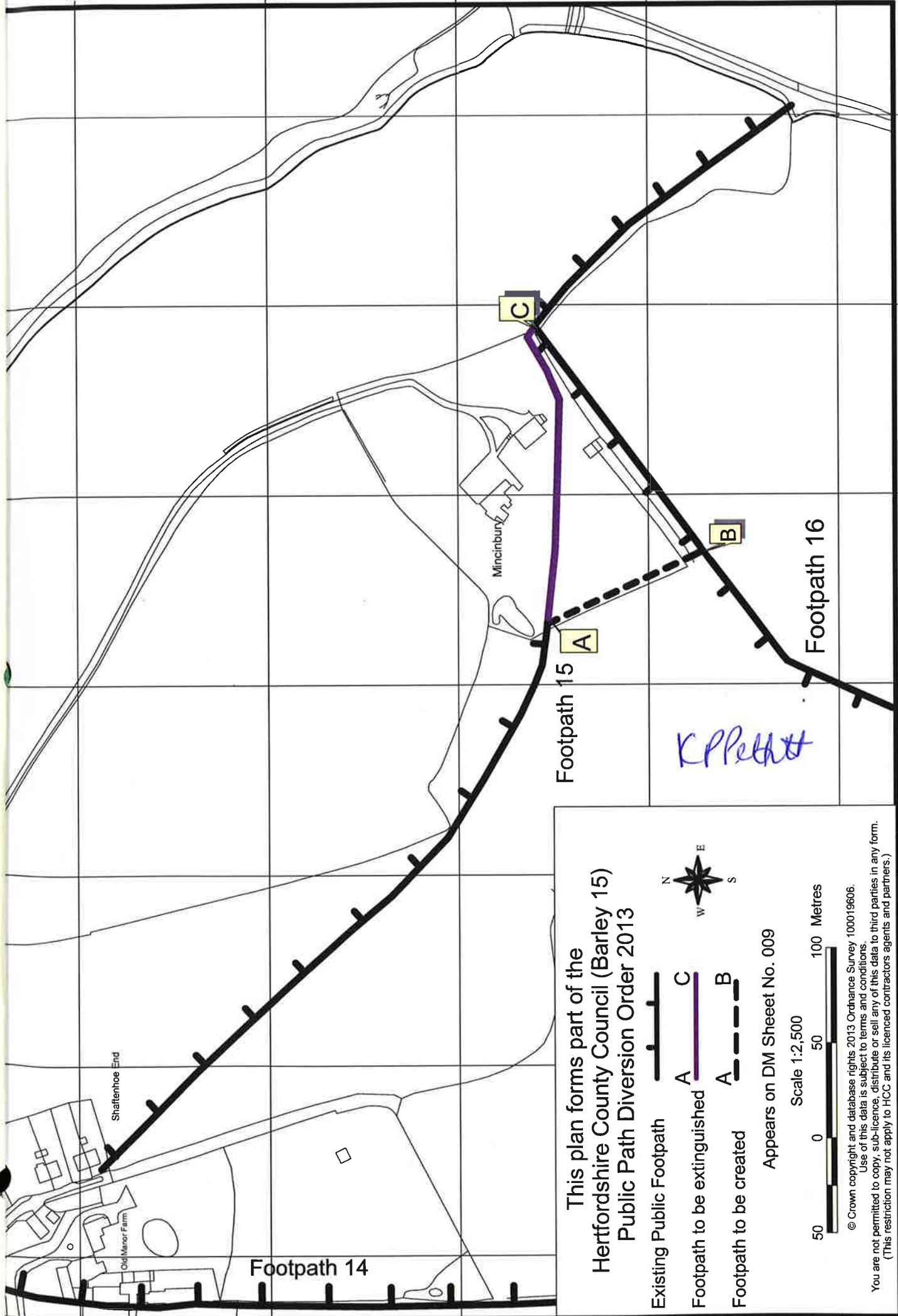

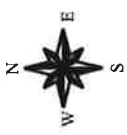

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

The full width of that part of Barley 15 running from TL 4113 3755 (Point A on the Order Plan) in an irregular but generally easterly direction for a distance of approximately 160 metres to its junction with Barley 16 at TL 4128 3755 (Point C on the Order Plan).

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

From TL 4113 3755 (Point A on the Order Plan) running in a south south easterly direction for a distance of approximately 90 metres to a junction with Barley 16 at TL 4117 3747 (Point B on the Order Plan) and to be known as part of Barley 15.

Width: 3.5 metres
