

NOTICE OF MAKING PUBLIC PATH CREATION AGREEMENT

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 25

The Hanging Wood Public Path Creation Agreement 2010

Bourne End, near Hemel Hempstead

The above named Agreement, made on 17th December 2010 under section 25 of the Highways Act 1980, has the effect of creating the public bridleway running from Upper Bourne End Lane to a bridleway near the A41, as shown on the attached plan.

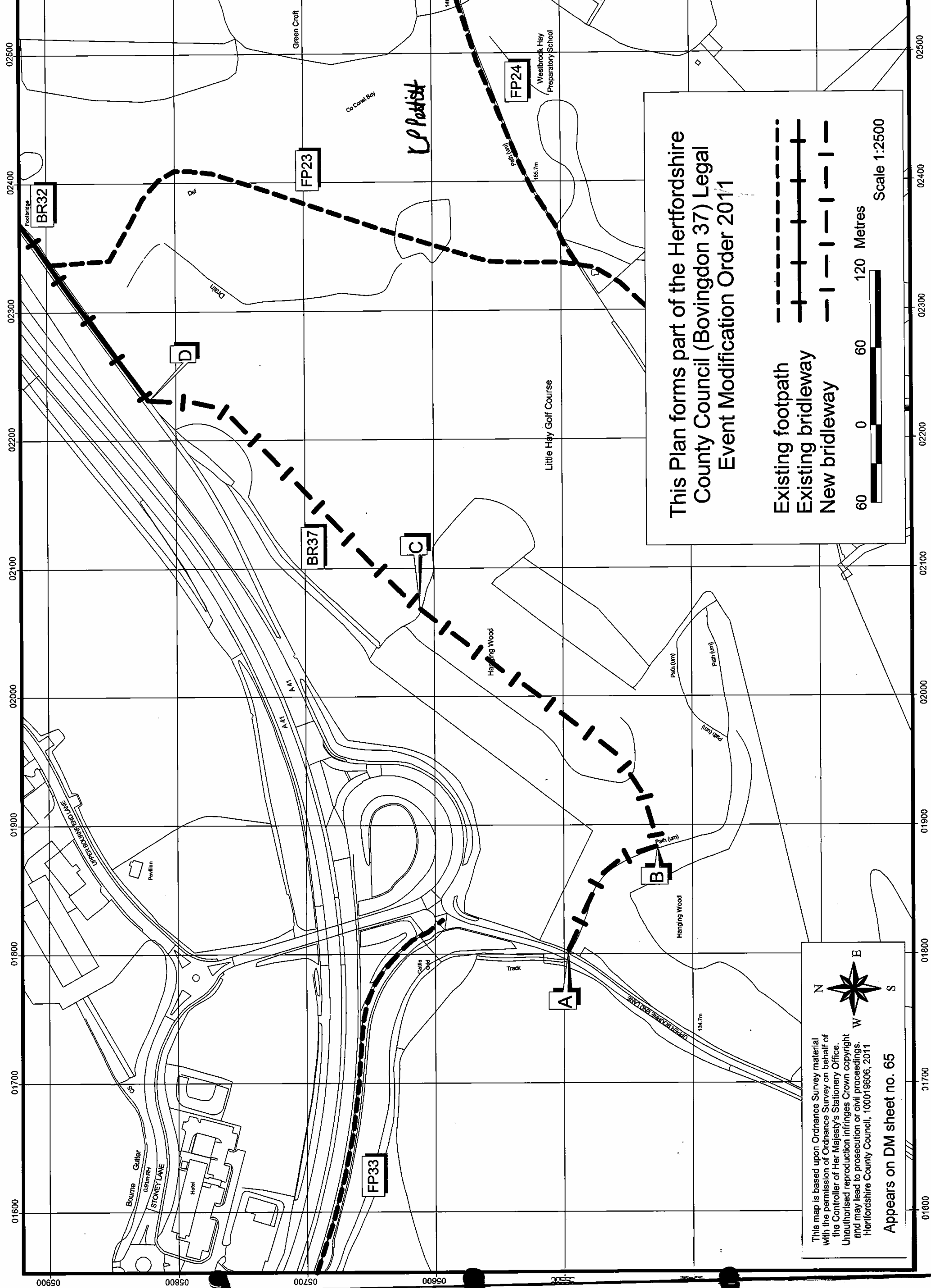
A public bridleway commencing at Upper Bourne End Lane (county road) at point A on the plan (TL 0180 0549) and continuing in a generally south easterly direction along the surfaced path through the woodland for approximately 110 metres to point B (TL 0188 0542) then continuing in a generally north easterly direction along the surfaced path through Hanging Wood for approximately 280 metres to the edge of the wood at point C (TL 0207 0561) then continuing in a generally north easterly direction along the surfaced path through the meadow for approximately 280 metres to the junction with Bovingdon Bridleway 32 at point D (TL 0223 0582)

Width: 4 metres

Limitations: none

Under section 25 there is no right of objection and the Agreement has taken immediate effect.
