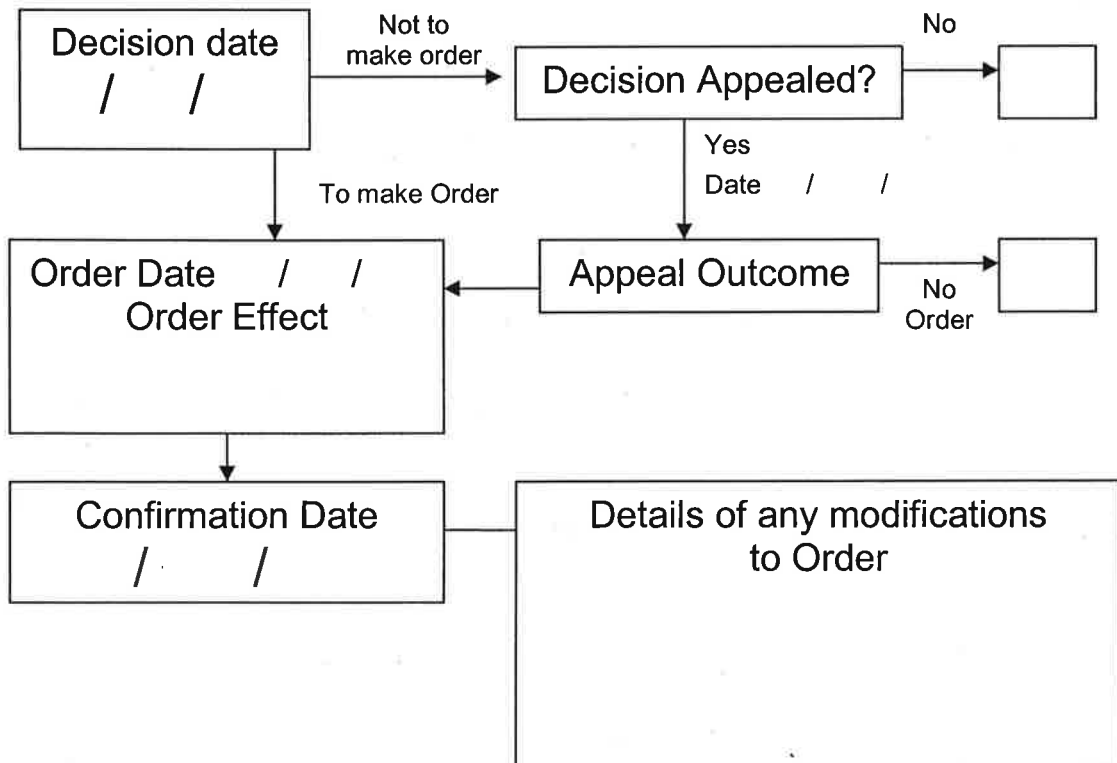

APPLICATION FOR DIVERSION/STOPPING UP ORDER OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

To enable the County Council to proceed the following information and agreement is required.

A. INFORMATION REQUIRED

B. AGREEMENT ON COSTS AND WORKS TO BE CARRIED OUT

In view of the costs involved in processing Orders the County Council makes such Order only upon the following conditions.

1. That, if it is decided to proceed, applicants will pay to the Council prior to the making of the Order:
 - a. £100 towards administrative expenses:
 - b. £150 for the true cost of posting the Notices on site:
 - c. £200 for the true cost of advertising in the local newspapers.

If objections are received and the County Council cannot confirm the Order it will be necessary to hold a Public Enquiry and a further charge will be made.

- a. £100 towards administrative expenses:
 - b. £200 as the true cost of advertising.
2. All fees are payable whether or not the Order is confirmed.
 3. That, in the case of Diversion Orders within 28 days of the confirmation of the proposed Order, applicants will carry out such work as, in the opinion of the County Surveyor, reasonably necessary both to ensure the safety and lawful use and passage of those using the new path.
 4. That in default of an applicant carrying out any or all of the work mentioned in (3)B above within the 28 days period mentioned, they will permit the Council or their contractors to enter on to their land for the purpose of carrying out the work themselves and will reimburse the Council for their expenses reasonably incurred in executing those works.

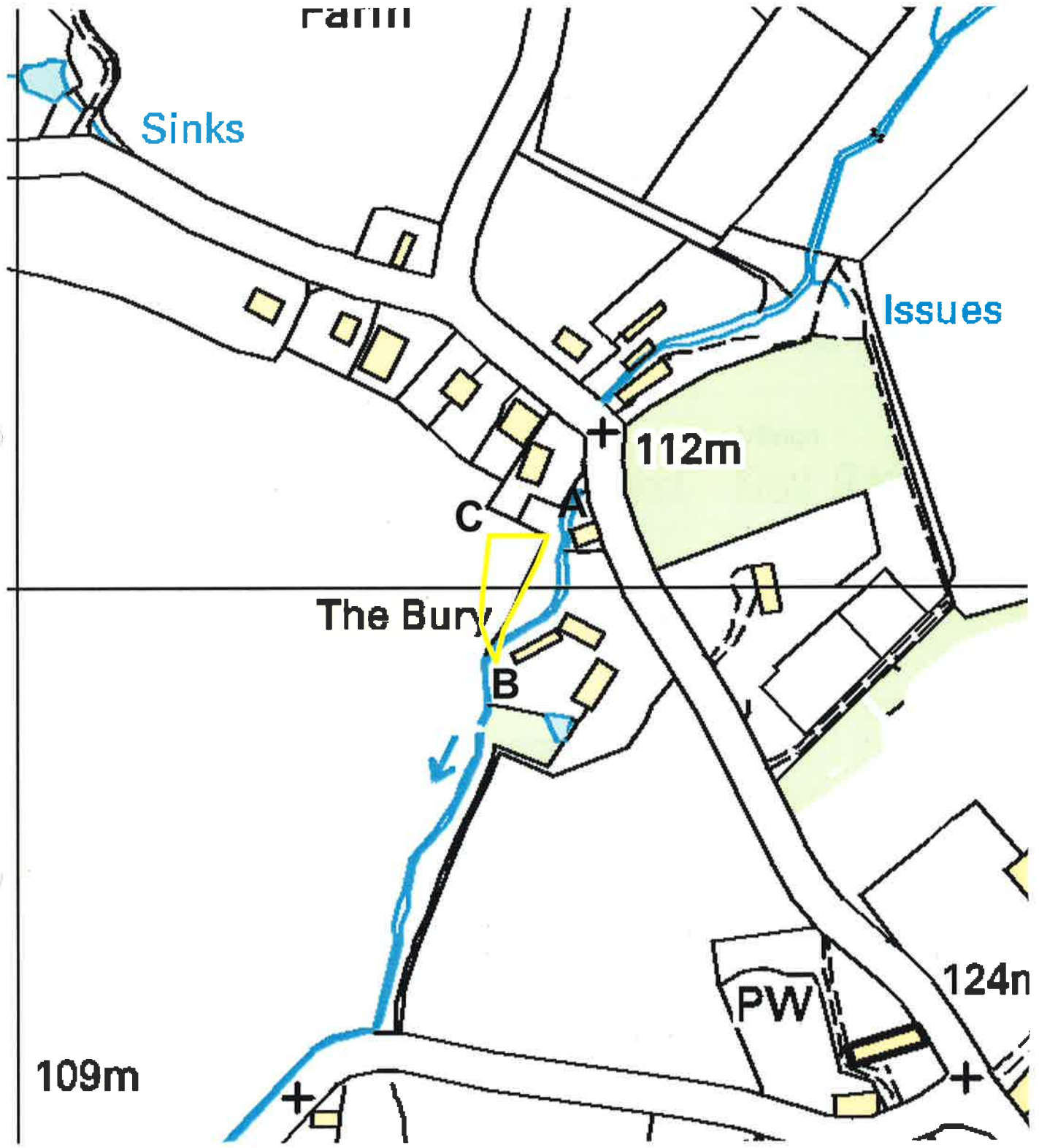
