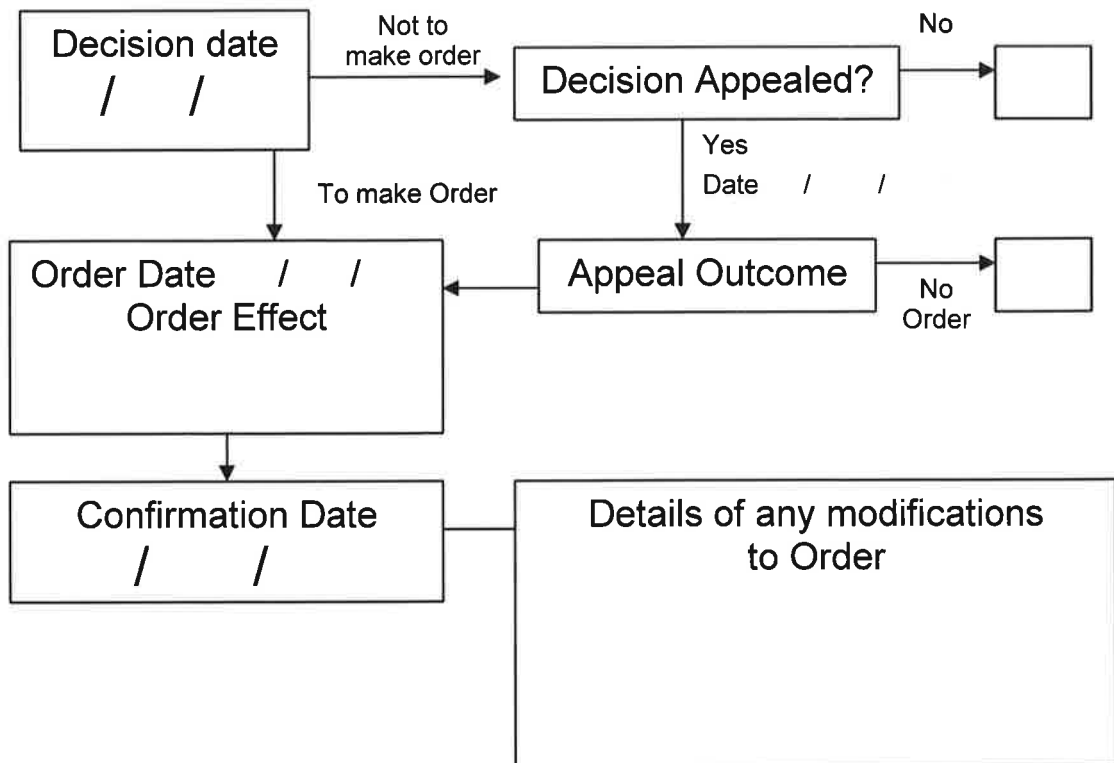

DETERMINATION (DECISION) OF APPLICATION

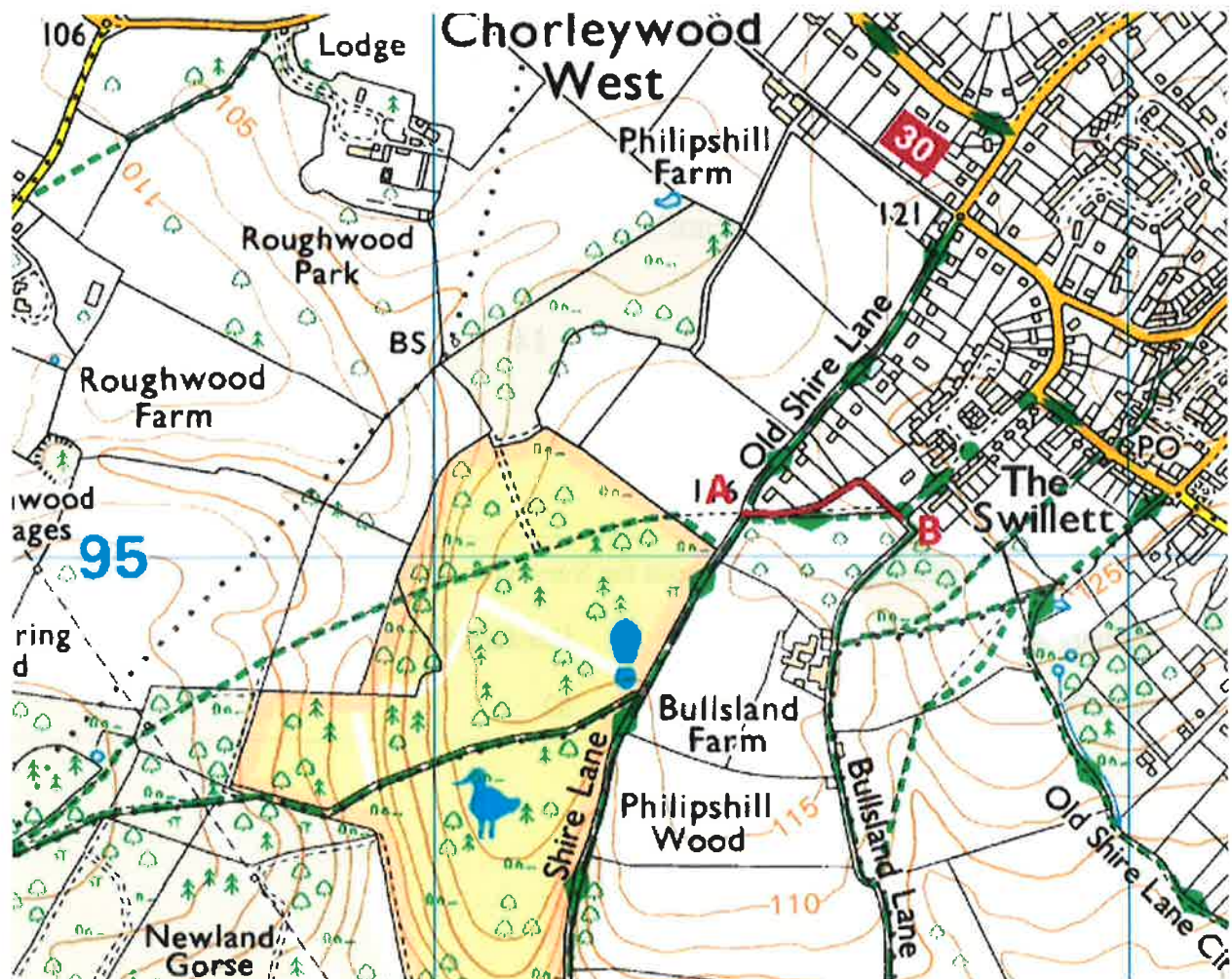


1. My name is Phil Wadey, and I have been a volunteer access and bridleways officer for the British Horse Society since 1992, including 14 years as the Society's regional access officer for the East of England. I am the applicant for the order.

THE APPLICATION ROUTE

2. The application route runs from Old Shire Lane (county road 8U394/10) to Bullsland Lane (county road 8U81/10). The application route is not currently shown on the definitive map of rights of way for Hertfordshire. It is shown on the plan below from point B (junction with Old Shire Lane) to B (Bullsland Lane).

3. The route's width is as shown uncoloured on the Inland Revenue Valuation Plan.

DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE OF HIGHWAY STATUS

4. In order to be able to modify the definitive map and statement, the Surveying Authority needs to have a discovery of evidence which shows, on the balance of probabilities, that highway rights exist. The use of the 'balance of probabilities' test rather than 'beyond reasonable doubt' was confirmed by the High Court in *Todd, Bradley v SOS for EFRA* [2004] 4 All ER 497.
