TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State gives notice of the proposal to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of a length of Throcking Lane at Buntingford, in the District of East Hertfordshire.

If made, the Order would authorise the stopping up only to enable development as permitted by East Herts Council under reference 3/13/1375/OP.

Copies of the draft Order and relevant plan will be available for inspection during normal opening hours at East Herts Council, Wallfields, Pegs Lane, Hertford SG13 8EQ in the 28 days commencing on 24 November 2016, and may be obtained, free of charge, from the address stated below (quoting NATTRAN/E/S247/2514).

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

THE STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAY (EAST) (NO.) ORDER 201

The Secretary of State makes this Order in exercise of powers under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act").

1. The Secretary of State authorises the stopping up of the highway described in the Schedule to this Order and shown on the plan, in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted under Part III of the Act by East Herts Council under reference 3/13/1375/OP.

2. (1) The developer shall to the reasonable satisfaction of the Council provide:-

(a) a new highway which shall be a road along the route shown by stipple on the plan; and

(b) improvement of the highway Throcking Lane shown by cross hatching on the plan.

(2) The new road shall be a highway which for the purposes of the Highways Act 1980 is a highway maintainable at the public expense and the Council shall be the highway authority for it.

3. Where immediately before the date of this Order there is any apparatus of statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across any highway authorised to be stopped up pursuant to this Order then, subject to section 261(4) of the Act, those undertakers shall have the same rights as respects that apparatus after that highway is stopped up as they had immediately beforehand.

4. In this Order -

"the Council" means Hertfordshire County Council

"the developer" means Redrow Homes (Eastern)

"the plan" means the plan numbered NATTRAN/E/S247/2514, marked "Highway at Buntingford in the District of East Hertfordshire", signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department for Transport, Deposit Document Service, F Floor, Ashdown House, St Leonards-on-Sea, Hastings, East Sussex TN37 7GA.

5. This Order shall come into force on the date on which notice that it has been made is first published in accordance with section 252(10) of the Act, and may be cited as the Stopping Up of Highway (East) (No.) Order 201.

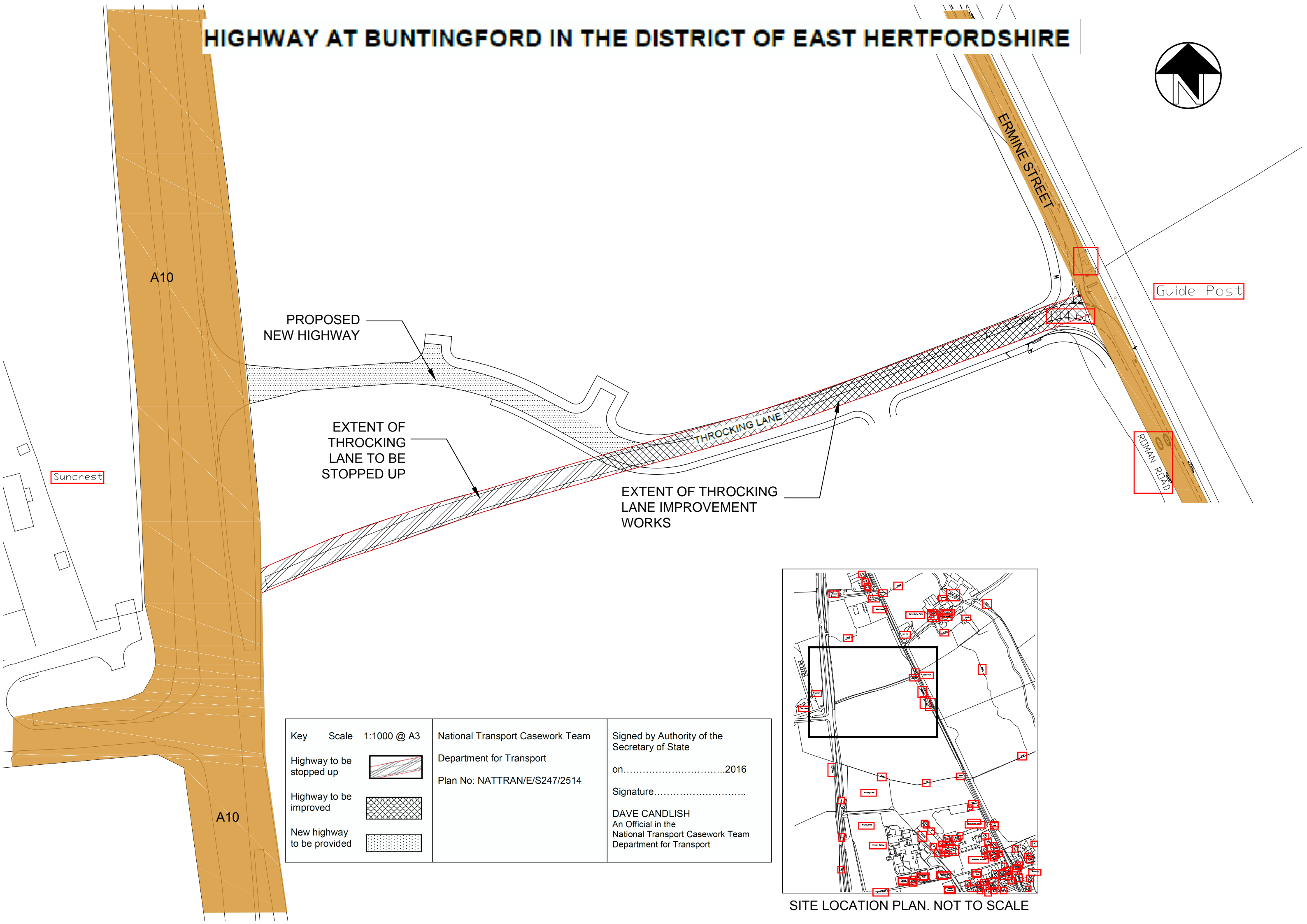
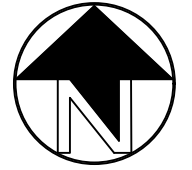

THE SCHEDULE

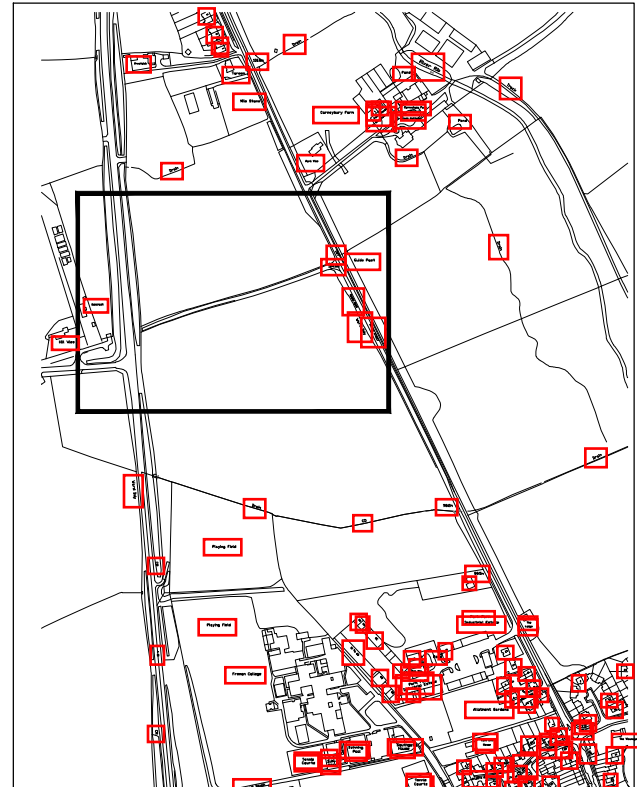
Description of highway to be stopped up

The highway to be stopped up is at Buntingford in the District of East Hertfordshire and is shown on the plan as a length of Throcking Lane. It commences from its junction with the A10 and extends in a north easterly direction for a distance of 117.33 metres.
