

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER

Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Definitive Map and Statement of Public
Rights of Way in Hertfordshire

The Hertfordshire County Council (Great Gaddesden 35, 37, 39, 83 and 84) Modification Order 2016

The above Order made on 4th March 2016, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:-

Deleting from them the full width of part of Great Gaddesden Bridleway 39 from its junction with Cupid Green Lane at TL 0630 1137 (point L on Part 2 of the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 390 metres to the junction with Gaddesden Lane at TL 0657 1166 (point M on Part 2 of the Order Plan).

Adding to them a public footpath commencing at the junction with Red Lion Lane (public road) at TL 0446 1121 (point A on Part 1 of the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally south easterly direction through the field for approximately 215 metres to the junction with Great Gaddesden 37 at TL 0460 1105 (point B on Part 1 of the Order Plan).

Adding to them a public byway open to all traffic commencing at the junction with Great Gaddesden 35 and 37 at TL 0465 1105 (point D on Part 1 of the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally east south easterly direction on the southern side of the field boundary for approximately 305 metres to the north west corner of Millhill Gorse at TL 0494 1097 (point F on Part 1 of the Order Plan), then continuing in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 575 metres along the north west boundary of Millhill Gorse and west side of Chalkpit Dell to join Great Gaddesden 39 at TL 0479 1047 (point G on Part 1 of the Order Plan).

Upgrade Great Gaddesden Bridleway 37 and Great Gaddesden Footpath 35 to byway open to all traffic, commencing at the junction with Red Lion Lane (public road) south west of the Crown & Sceptre public house at TL 0436 1110 (point C on Part 1 of the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally easterly and north easterly direction along the track historically known as Rolph's Lane for approximately 2,005 metres (past the junctions with Great Gaddesden Footpath 83 at TL 0460 1105 (point B on Part 1 of the Order Plan) and Great Gaddesden Byway Open to all Traffic 84 at TL 0465 1105 (point D on Part 1 of the Order Plan)) to join Gaddesden Row (public road) between Holly Cottage and Elmtree Farm at TL 0586 1221 (point E on Part 2 of the Order Plan).

Upgrade part of Great Gaddesden Bridleway 39 to byway open to all traffic, commencing at the junction with Red Lion Lane (public road) at TL 0414 1030 (point H on Part 1 of the Order Plan) and continuing on the south side of the boundary in a generally north easterly direction along the track historically known as Garmer Lane for approximately 430 metres to the junction with Great Gaddesden Footpath 38 at TL 0455 1029 (point I on Part 1 of the Order Plan), then continuing along the track on the north side of the boundary for approximately 470 metres, past the junction with Great Gaddesden Byway Open to all Traffic 84 at TL 0478 1046 (point G on Part 1 of the Order Plan), to Garmer Spring and the junction with Great Gaddesden Footpath 56 at TL 0492 1055 (point J on Part 1 of the Order Plan). Continuing along the track along the north west side of Garmer Spring and then on the south

side of the boundary for approximately 1,645 metres, past the junction with Great Gaddesden Bridleway 47 at TL 0556 1090 (point K on Part 1 of the Order Plan), to join Cupid Green Lane (public road) at TL 0630 1137 (point L on Part 2 of the Order Plan).

A copy of the Order and the Order Plan may be seen free of charge at Front Reception of Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford, from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday and at Dacorum Borough Council, Civic Offices, Hemel Hempstead, HP1 1HH. Copies of the Order and Plan may be bought at the price of £2.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to the Definitive Map Officer, Rights of Way Unit, Environment Department, Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford, Hertfordshire SG13 8DN (ref: HJD/DAC059) to arrive no later than 27th April 2016 and applicants must include particulars of the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Hertfordshire County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

This Order is made by Hertfordshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Hertfordshire require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3) (c)(i), (ii) and (iii) of the Act, namely the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows

- (i) that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, or that there is a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic or that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description; or
- (ii) that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description, or any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. Hertfordshire County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 1st March 2016.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Hertfordshire shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on Parts 1 and 2 of the plan attached to the Order ("the Order Plan").
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Hertfordshire County Council (Great Gaddesden 35, 37, 39, 83 and 84) Modification Order 2016.

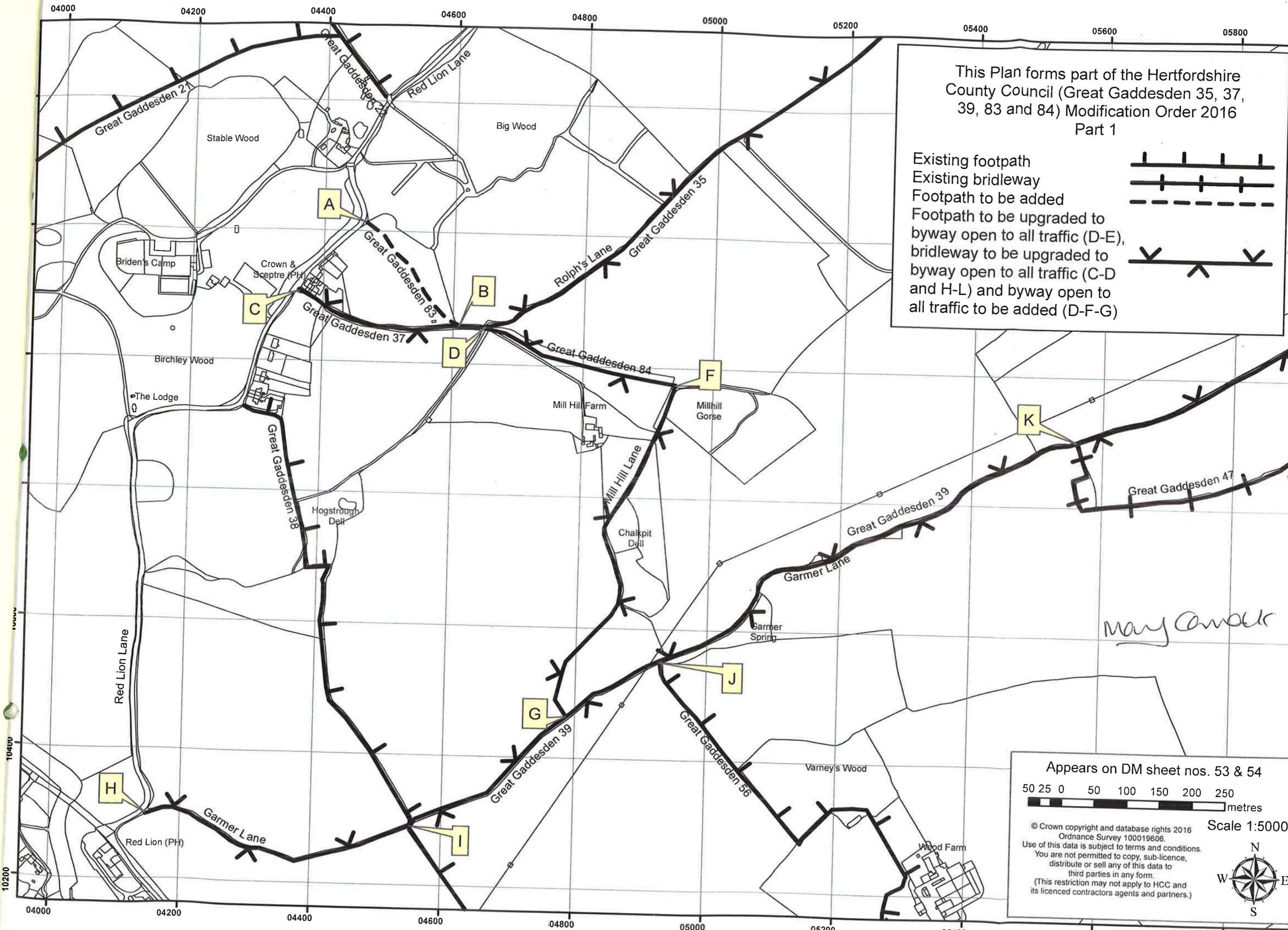

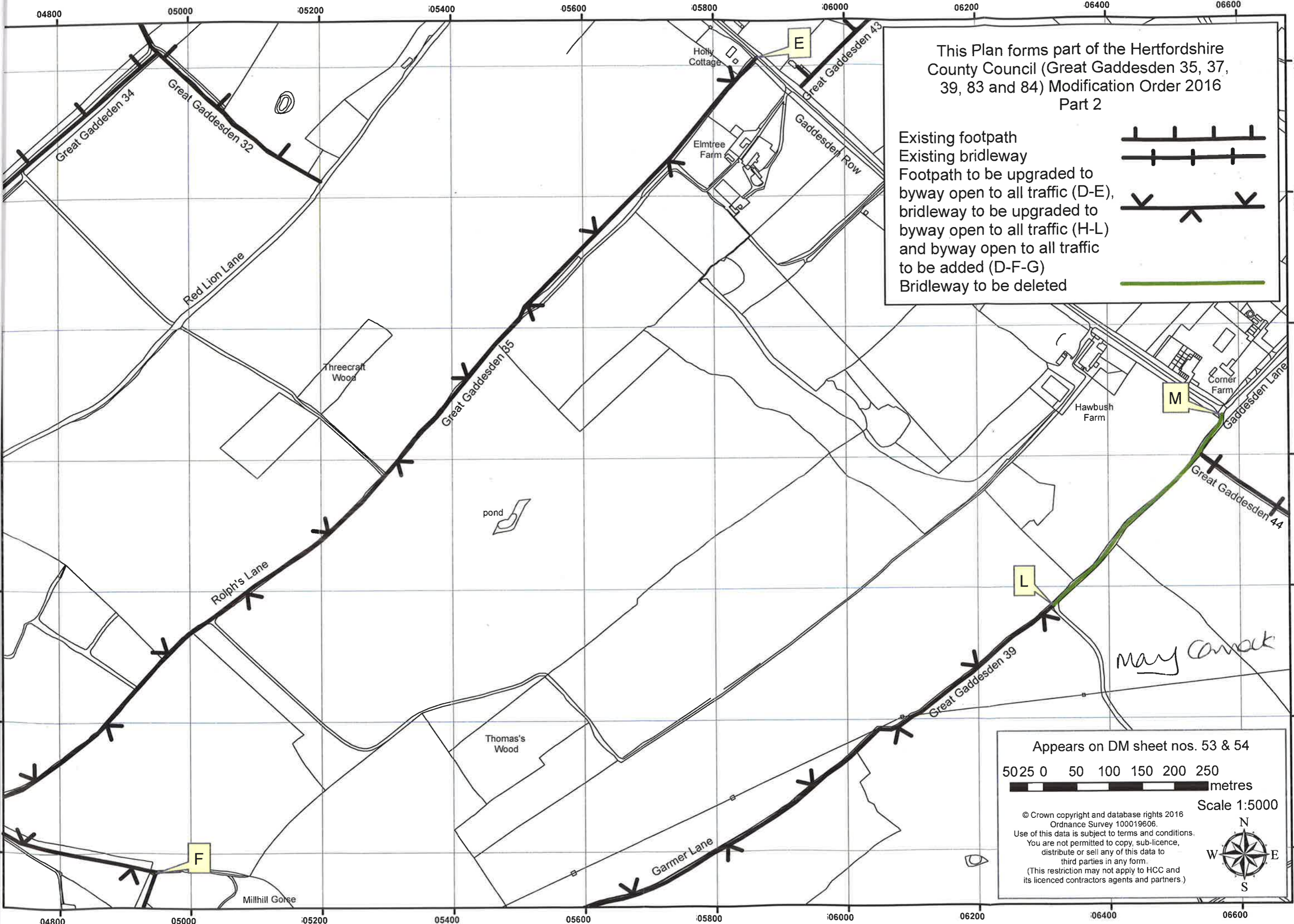

A public footpath commencing at the junction with Red Lion Lane (public road) at TL 0446 1121 (point A on Part 1 of the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally south easterly direction through the field for approximately 215 metres to the junction with Great Gaddesden 37 at TL 0460 1105 (point B on Part 1 of the Order Plan).

Width: 2 metres

A public byway open to all traffic commencing at the junction with Great Gaddesden 35 and 37 at TL 0465 1105 (point D on Part 1 of the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally east south easterly direction on the southern side of the field boundary for approximately 305 metres to the north west corner of Millhill Gorse at TL 0494 1097 (point F on Part 1 of the Order Plan), then continuing in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 575 metres along the north west boundary of Millhill Gorse and west side of Chalkpit Dell to join Great Gaddesden 39 at TL 0479 1046 ^{MPK} (point G on Part 1 of the Order Plan).

Upgrade Great Gaddesden Bridleway 37 and Great Gaddesden Footpath 35 to byway open to all traffic, commencing at the junction with Red Lion Lane (public road) south west of the Crown & Sceptre public house at TL 0436 1110 (point C on Part 1 of the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally easterly and north easterly direction along the track historically known as Rolph's Lane for approximately 2,005 metres (past the junctions with Great Gaddesden Footpath 83 at TL 0460 1105 (point B on Part 1 of the Order Plan) and Great Gaddesden Byway Open to all Traffic 84 at TL 0465 1105 (point D on Part 1 of the Order Plan)) to join Gaddesden Row (public road) between Holly Cottage and Elmtree Farm at TL 0586 1221 (point E on Part 2 of the Order Plan).

Upgrade part of Great Gaddesden Bridleway 39 to byway open to all traffic, commencing at the junction with Red Lion Lane (public road) at TL 0414 1030 (point H on Part 1 of the Order Plan) and continuing on the south side of the boundary in a generally north easterly direction along the track historically known as Garmer Lane for approximately 430 metres to the junction with Great Gaddesden Footpath 38 at TL 0455 1029 (point I on Part 1 of the Order Plan), then continuing along the track on the north side of the boundary for approximately 470 metres, past the junction with Great Gaddesden Byway Open to all Traffic 84 at TL 0478 1046 (point G on Part 1 of the Order Plan), to Garmer Spring and the junction with Great Gaddesden Footpath 56 at TL 0492 1055 (point J on Part 1 of the Order Plan). Continuing along the track along the north west side of Garmer Spring and then on the south side of the boundary for approximately 1,645 metres, past the junction with Great Gaddesden

Bridleway 47 at TL 0556 1090 (point K on Part 1 of the Order Plan), to join Cupid Green Lane (public road) at TL 0630 1137 (point L on Part 2 of the Order Plan).
