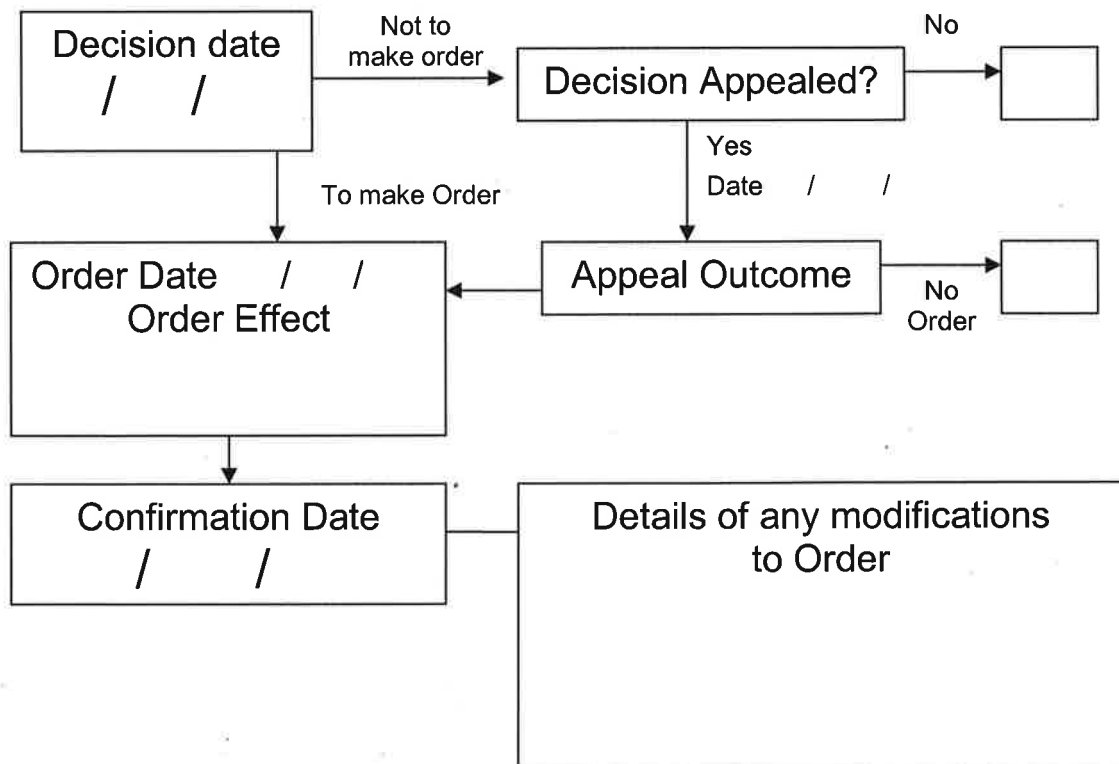

Batford, Harpenden. At the start it goes between gardens of the two houses in Salisbury Rd. After a dog-leg it goes down to the main road between the builders yard & pub car park. On right it's flanked by brick walls & on left by wood fencing. It is an urban route & short cut linking one part of Batford with another.
