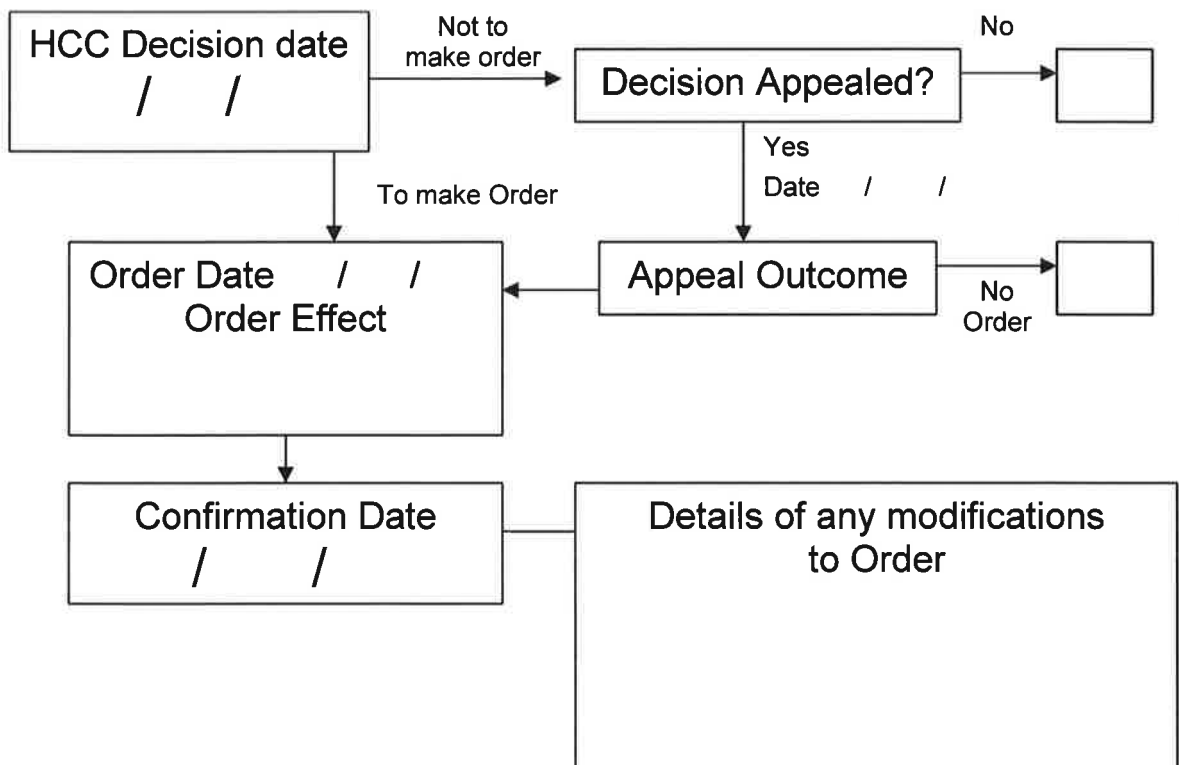

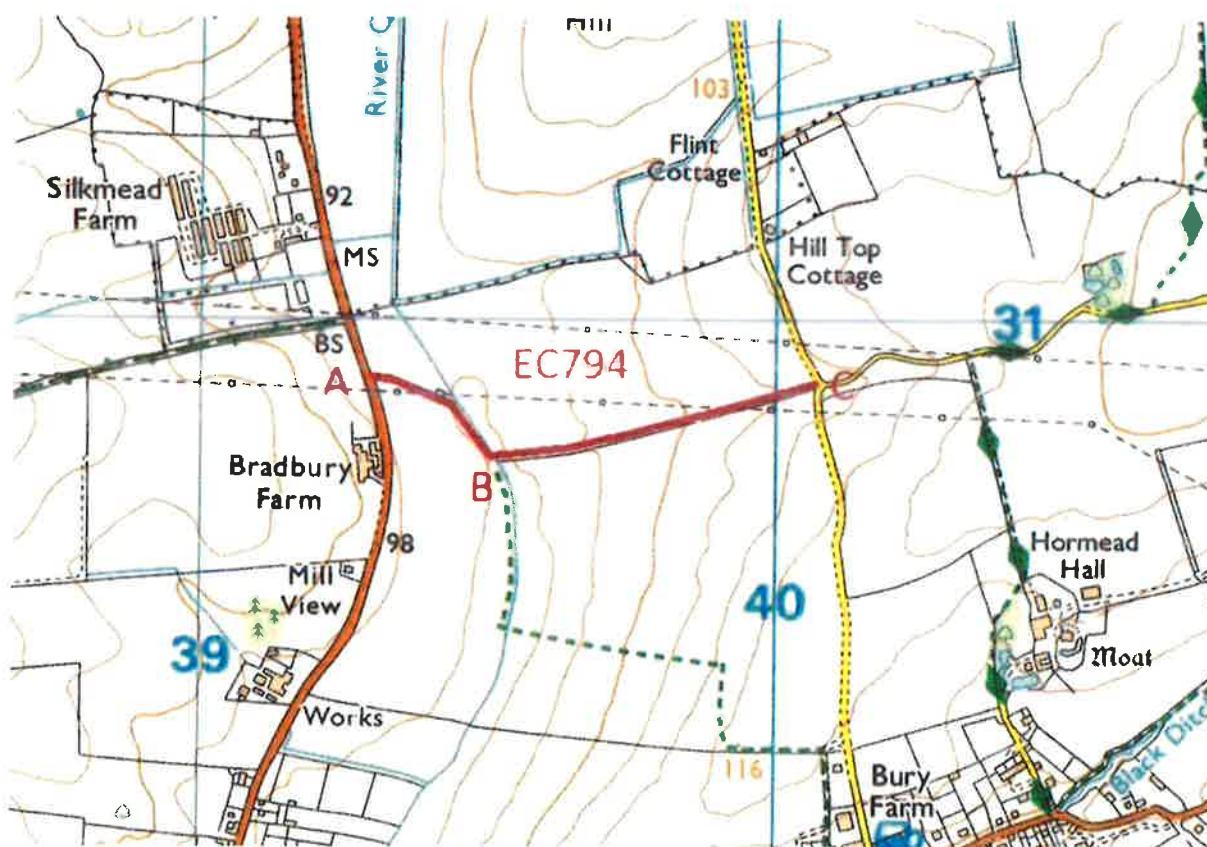




1. My name is Phil Wadey. I am the applicant for the order. My rights of way experience stems from having been a volunteer access and bridleways officer for the British Horse Society since 1992, including 14 years as the Society's regional access officer for the East of England, and from my being a trustee of the Open Spaces Society.
2. This application is made because, on the cut off day,
  - a. The effect of s.53(3) and (4)(c) Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000 on a public path that existed prior to 1949 is to extinguish the vehicular rights on a route shown in the definitive map and statement as a bridleway.

#### THE APPLICATION ROUTE

3. The application route runs from the B1368 (a classified road) to Anderson's Lane (a county road). The application route is shown on the plan below from point A (junction with B1368) to point C (junction with Anderson's Lane). It currently shown on the definitive map of rights of way for Hertfordshire as Hormead 1 BW from A to B, and Hormead 3 BW from B to C.
4. The route's width is as shown uncoloured on the Inland Revenue Valuation Plan.

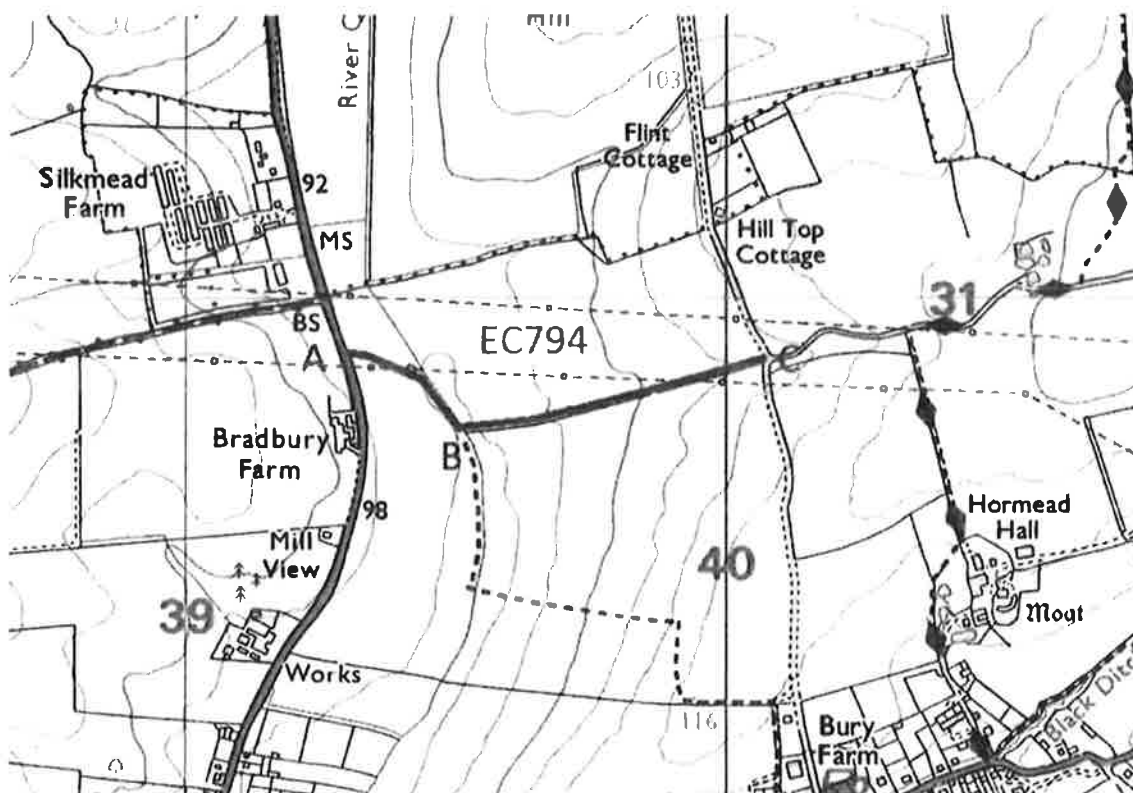
