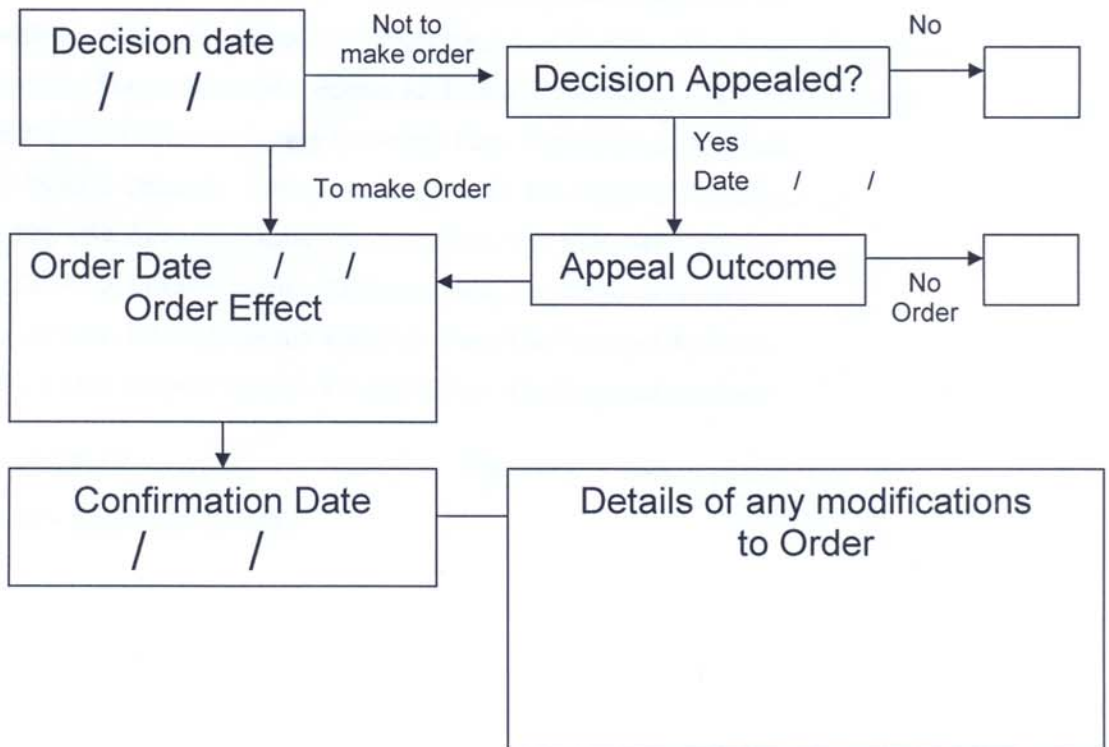

I, Dr Philip David Wadey of 12 Home Close, Corsham, Wiltshire SN13 0BE hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:

Adding the restricted byway from the route from The Street (a county road) to Byway Open to All Traffic 18, to Footpath 19, and

Upgrading to restricted byway the footpath 19 from the above junction to Byway Open to All Traffic 41

and shown on the map accompanying this application.

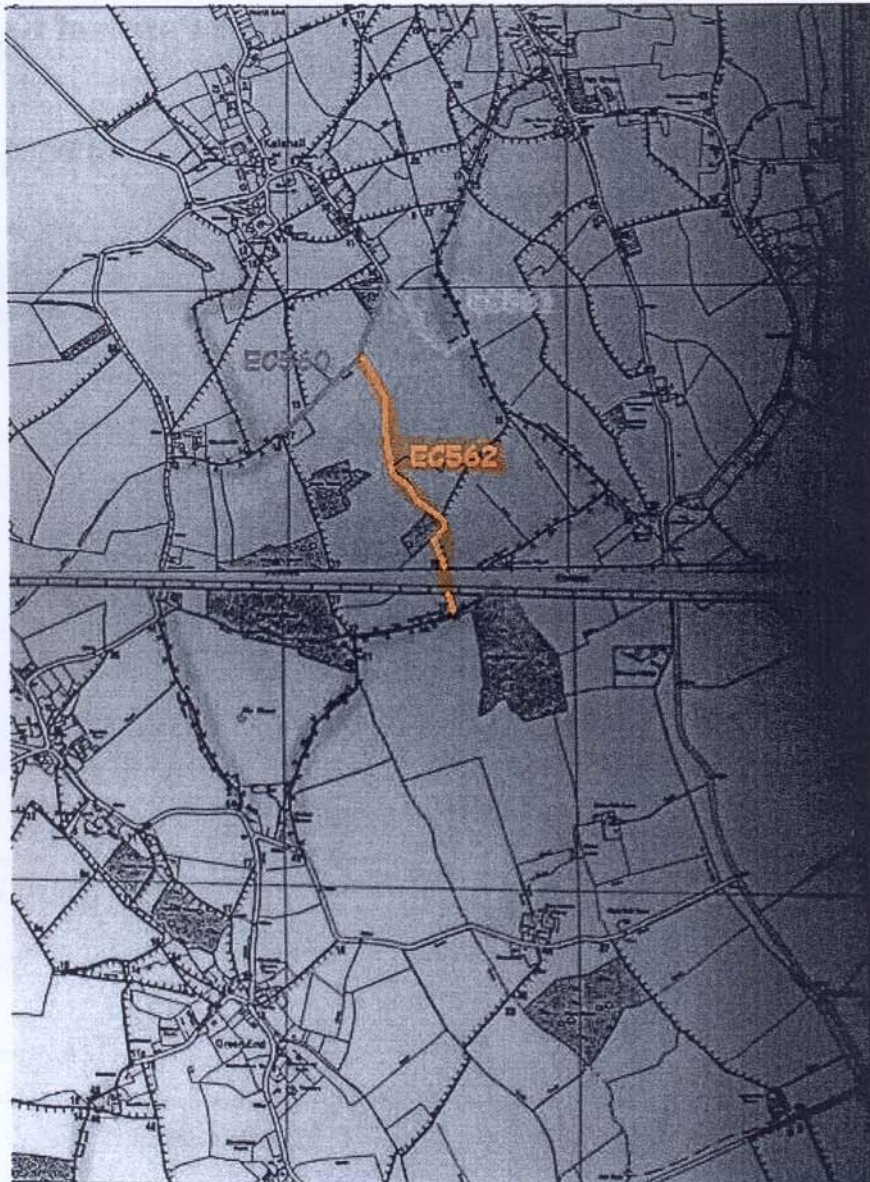

1. My name is Phil Wadey, and I have been the British Horse Society's regional access and bridleways officer for the East of England since 1996. I am the applicant for the order, on behalf of the Society.

2. Application route EC560 runs from The Street (a county road) to Byway Open to All Traffic 18, as shown in red in the annotated extract from the 2005 definitive map below. The application route EC561 runs from The Street (a county road) to Byway Open to All Traffic 19, as shown in blue in the annotated extract from the 2005 definitive map below. **The application route EC562 runs from EC560 Therfield to Byway Open to All Traffic 41, as shown in yellow in the annotated extract from the 2005 definitive map below.** Application routes EC560 and EC561 are not currently shown on the definitive map of rights of way for Hertfordshire. Route EC562 is partially shown as Kelshall 19 FP with the remainder unshown.
