

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF MODIFICATION ORDER

Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Definitive Map and Statement of Public
Rights of Way in Hertfordshire

Hertfordshire County Council (Kings Langley 47) Modification Order 2016

The above named Order, made on 6th May 2016 was confirmed with modifications by an Inspector acting for the Secretary of State for the Environment on 12th March 2019.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement by adding a public footpath commencing from the junction with Kings Langley Footpath 17 at TL 0606 0398 and continuing in a generally westerly direction for approximately 375 metres on the southern side of the field north of Lady Meadow, crossing Kings Langley Footpath 19 at TL 0568 0398, then continuing in a generally north westerly, north easterly then south easterly direction for approximately 395 metres around the western and northern boundaries of the field to the junction with Kings Langley Footpath 19 at TL 0582 0413.

A copy of the confirmed Order may be seen free of charge at Front Reception of Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford, from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday and can be bought from Hertfordshire County Council at a cost of £2. A copy of the confirmed Order and Notice may also be seen at Dacorum Borough Council, Civil Offices, Hemel Hempstead, HP1 1HH.

The Order becomes operative as from the date on which it was confirmed, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, or any regulation made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may, under paragraph 12 of Schedule 15 of the Act within 42 days from 5th April 2019, make application for the purpose of the High Court.

This Order is made by Hertfordshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Hertfordshire require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3) (c)(i) and (iii) of the Act, namely

(c) the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows

- (i) that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic; and
- (iii) that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description, or any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. Hertfordshire County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 13th April 2016.

The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Hertfordshire shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the plan forming part of this Order ("the Order Plan").

This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Hertfordshire County Council (Kings Langley 47) Modification Order 2016.

A public footpath commencing from the junction with Kings Langley Footpath 17 at TL 0605 0399 (point A on the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally westerly direction for approximately 375 metres on the southern side of the field north of Lady Meadow, crossing Kings Langley Footpath 19 at TL 0568 0398 (point B on the Order Plan), then continuing in a generally north westerly, north easterly then south easterly direction for approximately 395 metres around the western and northern boundaries of the field to the junction with Kings Langley Footpath 19 at TL 0582 0413 (point C on the Order Plan).

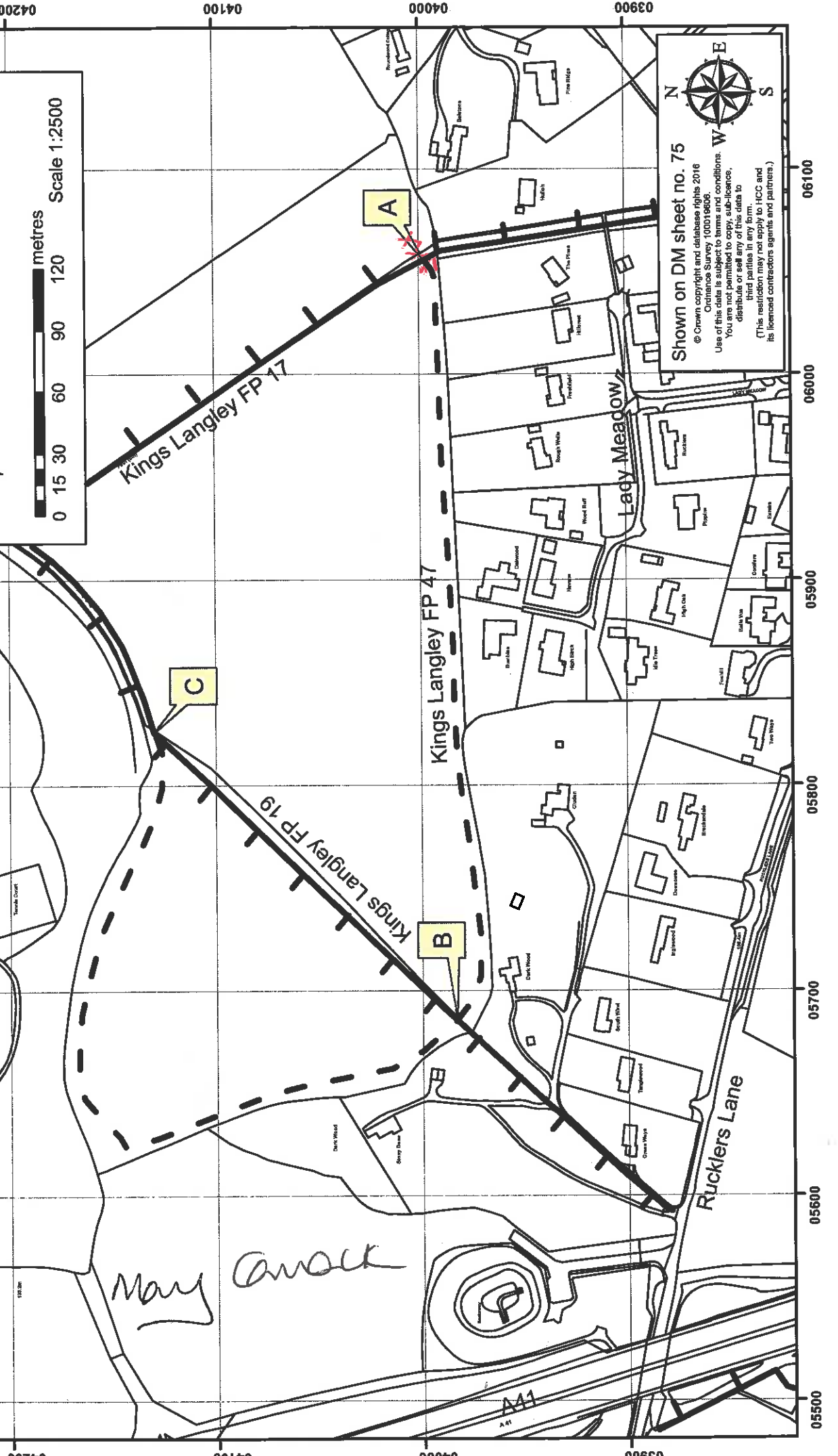
