**The Hertfordshire County Council (Langley 16)  
Modification Order 2004**

The above named Order, made on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2004, was confirmed without modification by an Inspector acting for the Secretary of State for the Environment on 5<sup>th</sup> July 2012.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement by upgrading to bridleway the footpath running from Hill End Farm generally south to Langley Lane.

A copy of the confirmed Order may be seen free of charge at Front Reception of Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford, from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday and can be bought from Hertfordshire County Council at a cost of £2. A copy of the confirmed Order and Notice may also be seen at North Hertfordshire District Council Offices, Gernon Road, Letchworth Garden City, SG6 3JF.

The Order becomes operative as from the date on which it was confirmed, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, or any regulation made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may, under paragraph 12 of Schedule 15 of the Act within 42 days from 9<sup>th</sup> August 2012, make application for the purpose of the High Court.

This Order is made by Hertfordshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Hertfordshire require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(ii) of the Act, namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes land to which the Order relates. Hertfordshire County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date shall be 14<sup>th</sup> July 2004
2. The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Hertfordshire shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the plan forming part of this Order ("the Order Plan").
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Hertfordshire County Council (Langley 16) Modification Order 2004

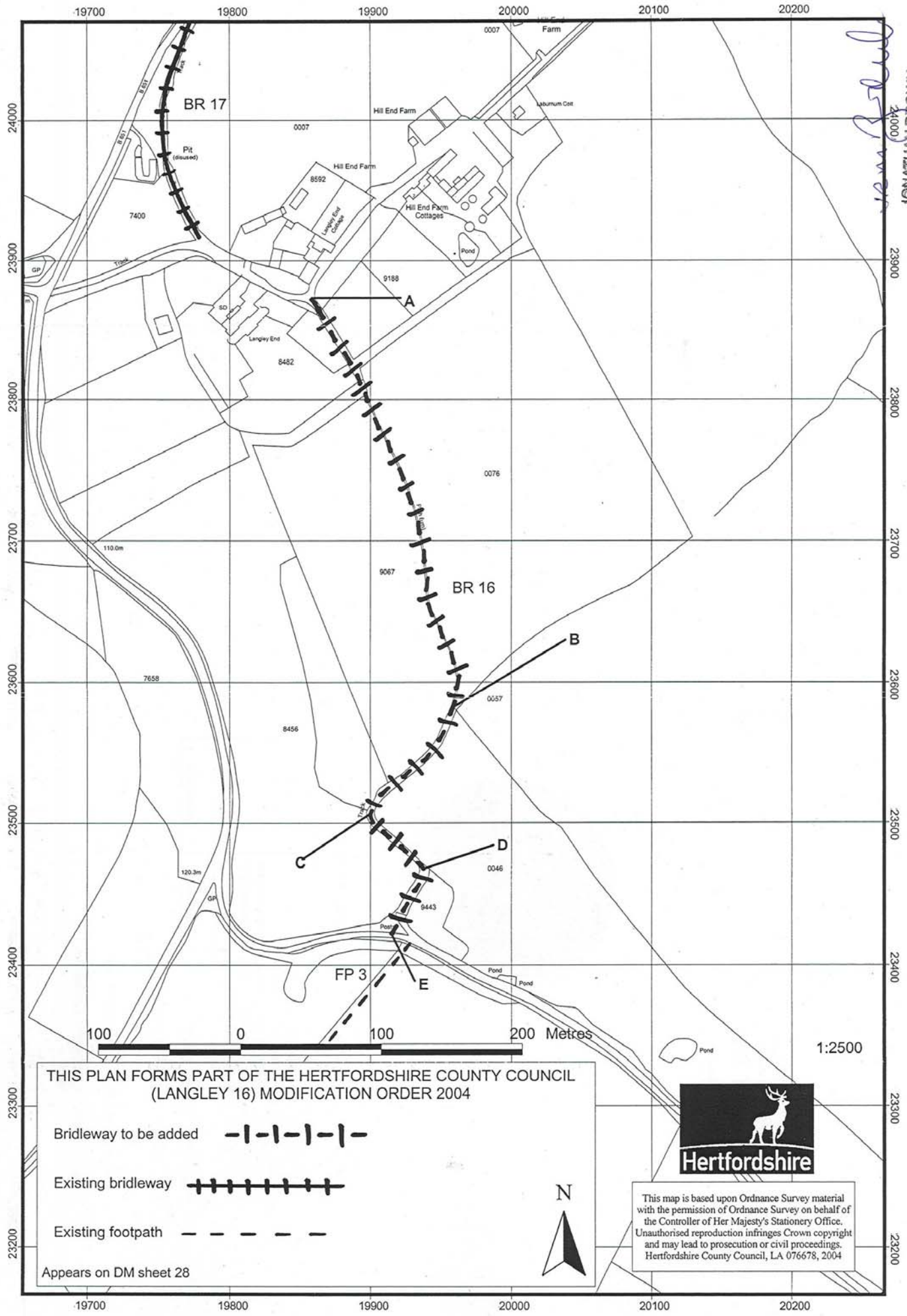
**DESCRIPTION OF PATH TO BE UPGRADED**

The footpath starts at the right-angled bend at Langley End at point A on the Order Plan (TL1986 2387) and runs generally south for approximately 310m to point B on the Order Plan (TL1996 2358). The route continues in a south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 90m to point C on the Order Plan (TL1990 2351), thence south-east for 55m to point D on the Order Plan (TL1994 2347). The route then runs south-west for 50m to point E on the order Plan (TL1992 2342). The effect of this upgrade is shown by a broken line with cross bars in the intervals on the Order Plan.

This footpath is to be upgraded to bridleway status.


