

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF A DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

**HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LILLEY 14)
DIVERSION ORDER 2016**

On 16th September 2016, Hertfordshire County Council confirmed the above Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is divert the public footpath running from TL 1136 2752 (point A on the Order Plan) north west for 40 metres to TL 1134 2755 (point C on the Order Plan) and north for 20 metres to TL 1134 2757 (point D on the Order Plan), onto a new route from TL 1136 2752 (point A on the Order Plan) north east for 10 metres to TL 1137 2753 (Point B on the Order Plan) following the north eastern side of the field boundary north west for 60 metres to TL 1134 2757 (point D on the Order Plan), as shown on the Order Plan.

A copy of the order and the order plan may be seen free of charge at front reception of Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford, from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday and at North Hertfordshire District Council, Council Offices, Gernon Road, Letchworth Garden City, SG6 3JF. Copies of the order and plan may be bought from Hertfordshire County Council at the price of £2.

The Order comes into force as from 6th October 2016, but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 6th October 2016, make an application to the High Court.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

Hertfordshire County Council (Lilley 14) Diversion Order 2016

This Order is made by Hertfordshire County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Trustees of H D Sowerby Settlement 1959 have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are included in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

North Hertfordshire District Council and Lilley Parish Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

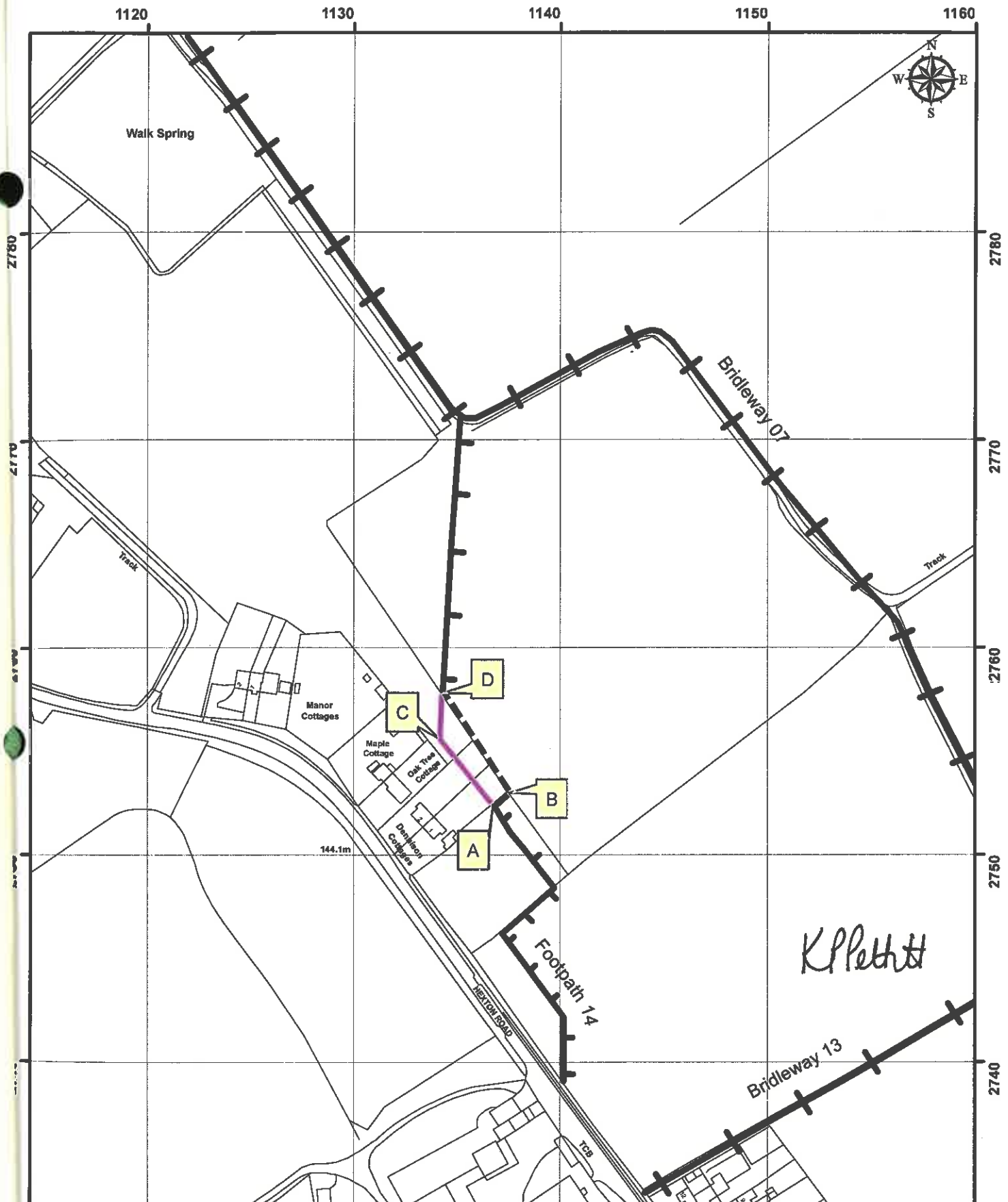
BY THIS ORDER

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Lilley and shown by a bold continuous line on the plan contained in this order ("the Order Plan") and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up on the date on which the authority certifies that the public footpath described in paragraph 2 below is in fit condition for use by the public such date not being earlier than 21 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 21 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Lilley described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Order Plan.
3. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART 1
DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

The full width of that part of Lilley 14 commencing from TL 1136 2752 (point A on the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 40 metres to TL 1134 2755 (point C on the Order Plan) and continuing in a northerly direction for approximately 20 metres to TL 1134 2757 (point D on the Order Plan).

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

Public footpath commencing at TL 1136 2752 (point A on the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 10 metres to TL 1137 2753 (Point B on the Order Plan) then following the north eastern side of the field boundary in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 60 metres to TL 1134 2757 (point D on the Order Plan).
