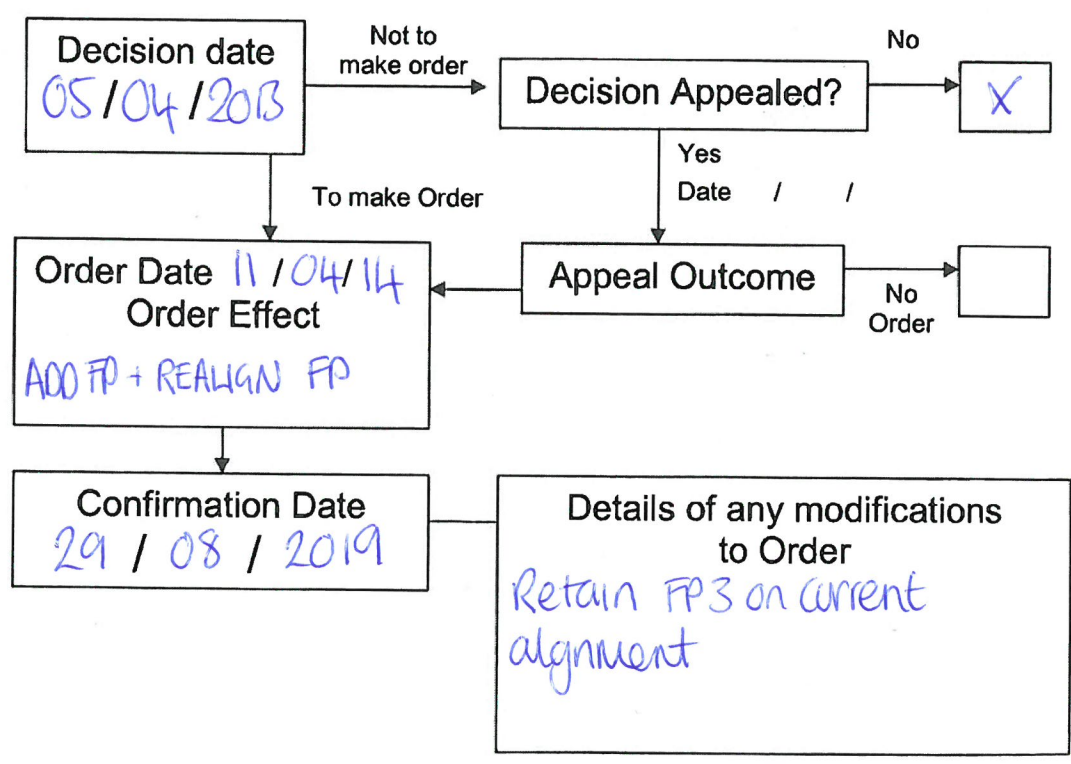

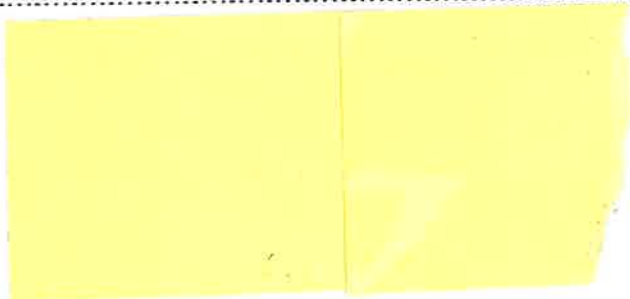

The footpath crosses the field at approx GR98551410, known locally as "Eddy's field". It diverges from FP2 at approx GR98611413 (approx. 43 metres from the stile at the NE entry of FP2 into the field and 40m to the E of the apex of the "dogleg" in the N boundary of the field) and in a generally SW direction towards the SW exit of the field into the alleyway towards Alderton Drive, joining FP3, but with a slight detour to avoid a cedar tree. The path is well marked on the grassy ground. The cedar tree is at approx GR98541406. The SW exit is at approx GR98511403 and is marked by the remains of a stile.

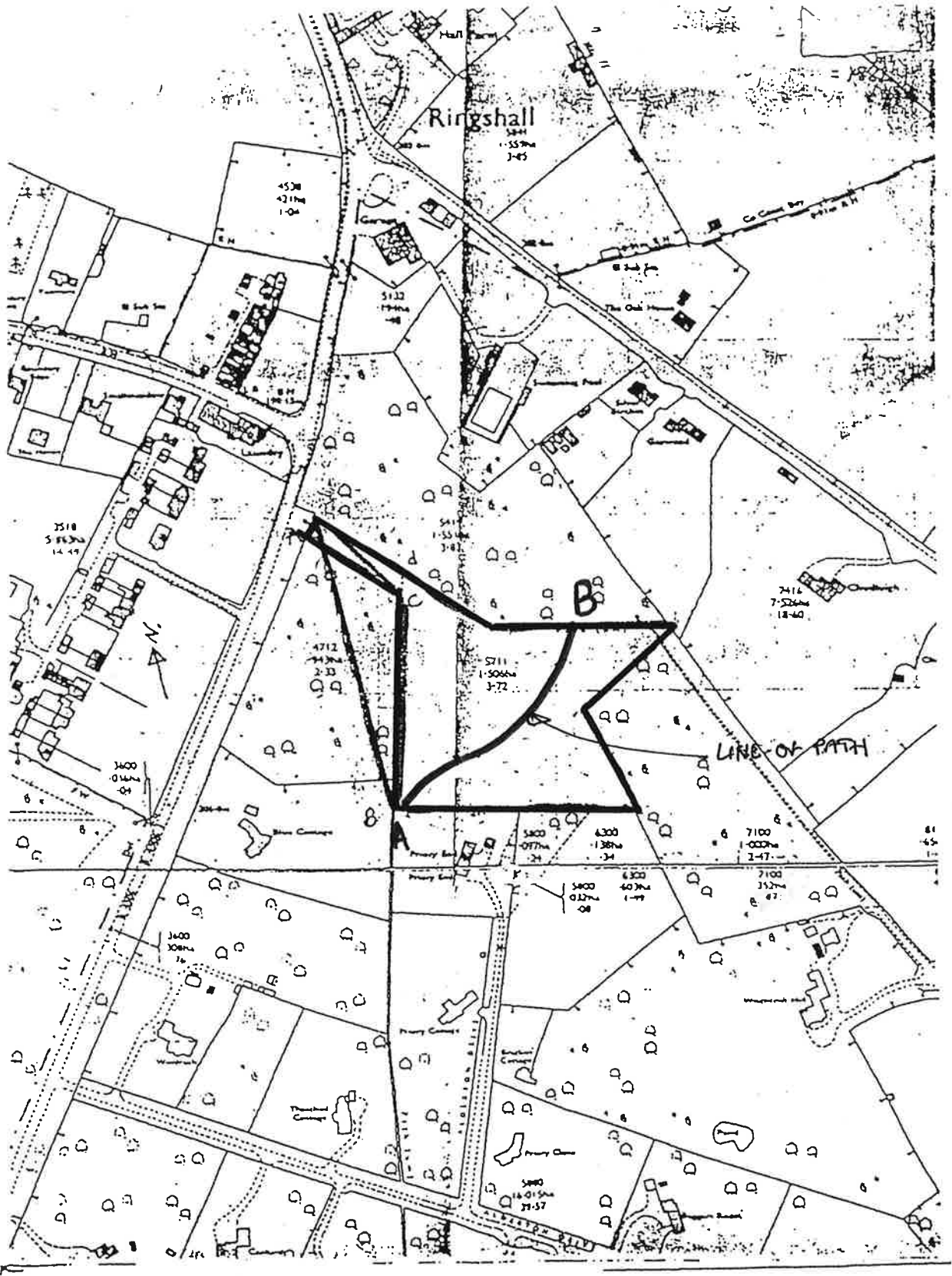
