Aspenden: Old Road/Bridleway (incorporates part of Aspenden 2 FP)**


Please find enclosed an application for a definitive map modification order to record a restricted byway and bridleway in Aspenden parish.

I, Dr Philip David Wadey of 12 Home Close, Corsham, Wiltshire SN13 0BE hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:

Upgrading to a restricted byway the footpath (part of Aspenden 2 FP) from The Street, Aspenden (Point A) to the end of the unregistered land at Point B;
Adding the bridleway from Point B to the boundary of the A10 (Point C);
Adding the bridleway from the boundary of the A10 (Point D) to Aspenden Road (Point E) and shown on the map accompanying this application.
