

A Consultation on the Proposed Extinguishment, Creation & Diversion of Six Footpaths in Tring Rural

The landowners have applied to Hertfordshire County Council to extinguish parts of Public Footpath Nos. 11, 12 and 13, where they cross Betlow Farm, Long Marston and to create new footpaths to replace them. They have also applied to divert parts of footpaths 14, 15 and 16. The proposed changes are shown on the attached plans. You are at Point **XX** the Plan.

The proposals seek to provide better links with the surrounding path network (e.g. Footpath 12 and 13 are currently cul-de-sacs, but if the proposed Orders take effect the new routes will link with other public rights of way in the area) and move the footpaths onto alignments which will allow for more efficient agricultural operations to be undertaken.

It should be noted that the Extinguishment Order will be considered concurrently with the Creation Order and will only be confirmed (take effect) by the County Council if the Creation Order is also confirmed (takes effect).
