

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF A DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

**HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (Rickmansworth 30)  
DIVERSION ORDER 2016**

On 15 April 2016 Hertfordshire County Council confirmed the above Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert that part of Rickmansworth 30 from running from the east end of Caravan Lane, through the St Joan of Arc school playing fields to the River Chess and to create a public footpath outside the school playing fields, running from the east end of Caravan lane, along the south side of railway line to the River Chess as shown on the Order Plan.

A copy of the order and the order plan may be seen free of charge at front reception of Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford, from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday and at Three Rivers District Council, Three Rivers House, Northway, Rickmansworth WD3 1RL. Copies of the order and plan may be bought from Hertfordshire County Council at the price of £2.

The Order comes into force as from 29 July 2016, but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 29 July 2016, make an application to the High Court.

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER**

This Order is made by Hertfordshire County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.


St Joan of Arc Catholic School has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order.

Three Rivers District Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

**BY THIS ORDER**

1. The public right of way over the land situate to the east of Caravan Lane, Rickmansworth shown by a bold continuous line on the plan contained in this Order ("the Order Plan") and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be stopped up 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. Notwithstanding this order the Eastern Electricity Board and its successors in title shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 namely: access under a Lease dated 13 November 1950 in relation to land which part of this public right of way shown by a bold continuous line on the Order Plan, crosses over.
3. There shall on the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate to the east of Caravan Lane, Rickmansworth described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line with short intervals on the Order Plan.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

**SCHEDULE**

**PART 1  
DESCRIPTION OF SITE AND EXISTING PATH OR WAY**

The full width of that part of Rickmansworth Footpath 30 commencing from TQ 0638 9471 (Point A on the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally south easterly direction across the school playing field for approximately 175 metres to TQ 0655 9467 (Point B on the Order Plan) and then turning to run east north east for approximately 70 metres to the ford and footbridge over the River Chess at TQ 0662 9469 (Point C on the Order Plan).

**PART 2  
DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY**

A public footpath commencing at TQ 0638 9471 (Point A on the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally easterly direction to the south of the railway fence for approximately 240 metres to the ford and footbridge over the River Chess at TQ 0662 9469 (Point C on the Order Plan).

Width: varies between 3 metres and 7 metres between TQ 0638 9471 (Point A on the Order Plan) and TQ 0662 9469 (Point C on the Order Plan) as shown shaded grey on the Order Plan, and is subject to mature trees.
