### **Application to upgrade parts of Sarratt Footpaths 36 & 37**

I recently informed you that the County Council decided that with regard to the above application there was insufficient evidence to make a modification order under section 53 of the Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981 to upgrade part of Sarratt footpaths 36 and 37 to Byway Open to All Traffic status. The applicant has exercised their right of appeal and has written to the Secretary of State asking him/her to reconsider our decision.
