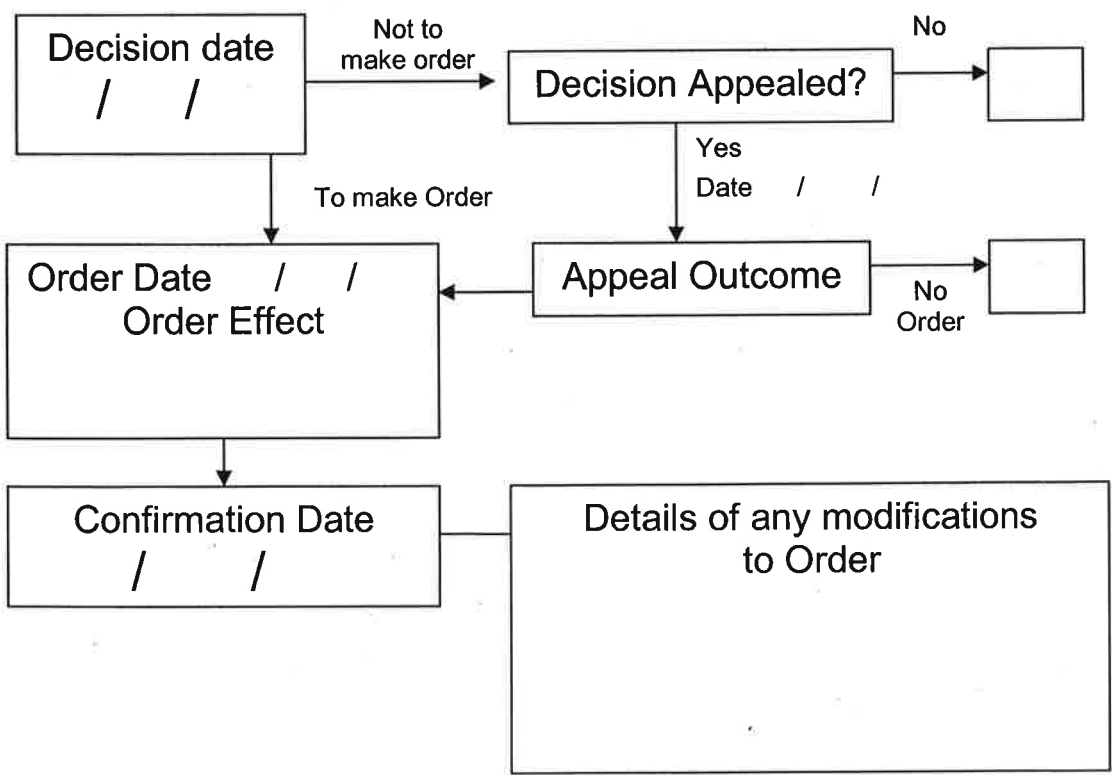

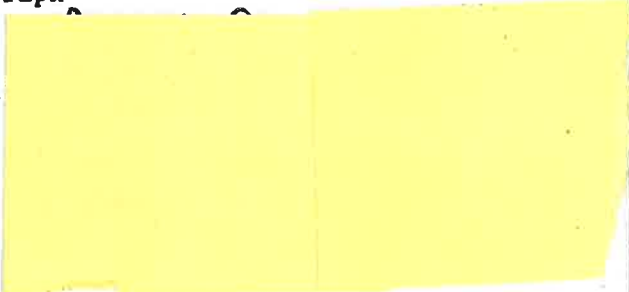

SUMMARY OF MODIFICATION ORDER CLAIM

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

1. Position

- (a) Location of each end of path North West corner of Churchyard (at FP No.28) to Knight Street.

 (Any prominent features, landmarks, roads, buildings, etc.)
 Parish Hall on South West side, School and grounds on North East side and access to garages and restaurant.
- (b) Six figure grid reference for each end of path 148 485
 to 149 484

2. Length (Metric)

The path is a length of 130 metres (37m plus 13m plus 80m)

3. Width

The path is a width of 37 metre length 4.65m wide consisting of grass verges of 2.15 and 1.25 metres respectively with footpath of 1.25 m.

 PLUS 13 metre length 1.25m wide
 PLUS 80 metre length 4.00m wide (BYWAY)

4. Nature of Surface

The surface consists of
 Loose stones and badly disrupted tarmacadam.

The path is used daily by a large number of children from the School and the day Nursery and by many elderly people going to church.
