

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF A DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

**HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (South Mimms 27)
DIVERSION ORDER 2015**

On 19 February 2016, Hertfordshire County Council confirmed the above Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public footpath running from the B556 St Albans Road, north of South Mimms to the M25 and then south east parallel with the M25 to join Footpath 29 and to create a public footpath running from the B556 generally south but further away from the widened M25 to join Footpath 29 as shown on the Order Plan.

A copy of the order and the order plan may be seen free of charge at front reception of Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford, from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday and at Hertsmere Borough Council Offices, Elstree Way, Borehamwood WD6 1WA.. Copies of the order and plan may be bought from Hertfordshire County Council at the price of £2.

The Order comes into force as from 9 March 2016, but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 9 March 2016, make an application to the High Court.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

**Hertfordshire County Council (South Mimms 27)
Diversion Order 2015**

This Order is made by Hertfordshire County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Skanska Balfour Beatty Joint Venture and successors in title have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Hertsmere Borough Council has been consulted in the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER

1. The public right of way over the land situate to the north of South Mimms between the B556 and the M25 in the Parish of South Mimms and shown by a bold continuous line on the plan contained in this Order ("the Order Plan") and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall on the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate to the north of South Mimms between the B556 and the M25 in the Parish of South Mimms as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Order Plan.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

The full width of South Mimms Footpath 27 commencing on the south west side of the B556 St Albans Road at TL 2164 0163 (Point A on the Order Plan) and running generally south west for approximately 100 metres to the M25 motorway boundary at TL 2155 0158 (Point B on the Order Plan), then turning to run generally south east alongside the M25 motorway for approximately 165 metres to join South Mimms Footpath 29 at TL 2163 0145 (Point C on the Order Plan).

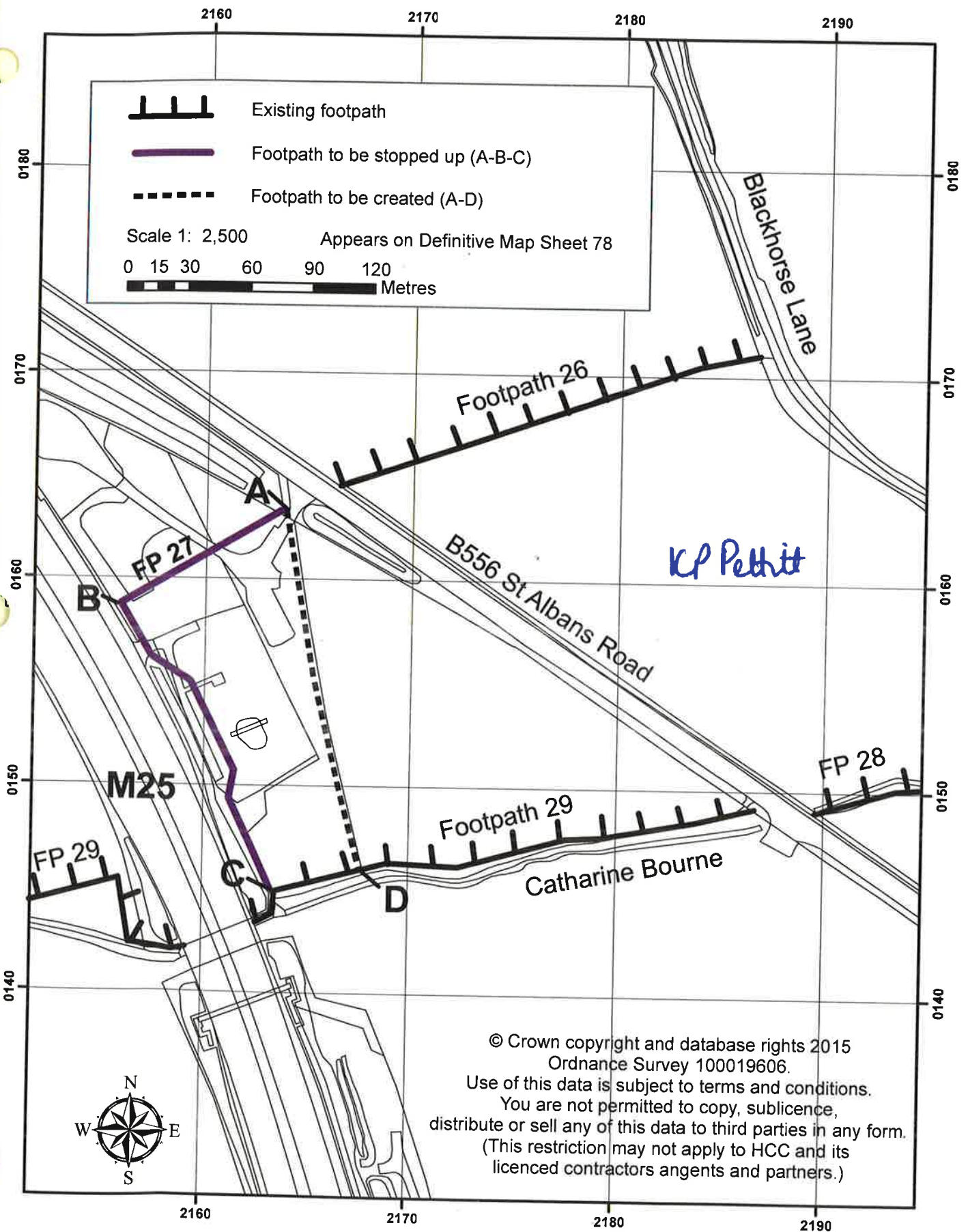
PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW ADDITIONAL PATH OR WAY

A public footpath commencing on the south west side of the B556 St Albans Road (public road) at TL 2164 0163 (Point A on the Order Plan) and running generally south south east for approximately 180 metres along the west side of a hedge to join South Mimms Footpath 29 at TL 2167 0146 (Point D on the Order Plan).

Width: 4 metres
