

**PUBLIC PATH CREATION ORDER**  
**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 26**  
**HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

**Hertfordshire County Council**  
**(ST STEPHEN 3)**  
**Creation Order 2016**

This order is made by Hertfordshire County Council ("the authority") under section 26 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that, having regard to the matters set out in section 26(1), there is a need for additional width to be added to the public bridleway over the land to which this order relates, and that it is expedient that the extra width for this path should be created.

St Albans City and District Council has been consulted as required by Section 26(3) of the 1980 Act.

**BY THIS ORDER**

1. There shall be on the date of confirmation of this Order a recorded width for the public bridleway described in the Schedule to this Order and shown in grey on the plan forming part of this Order ("the Order Plan").
2. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 2 of the Schedule.

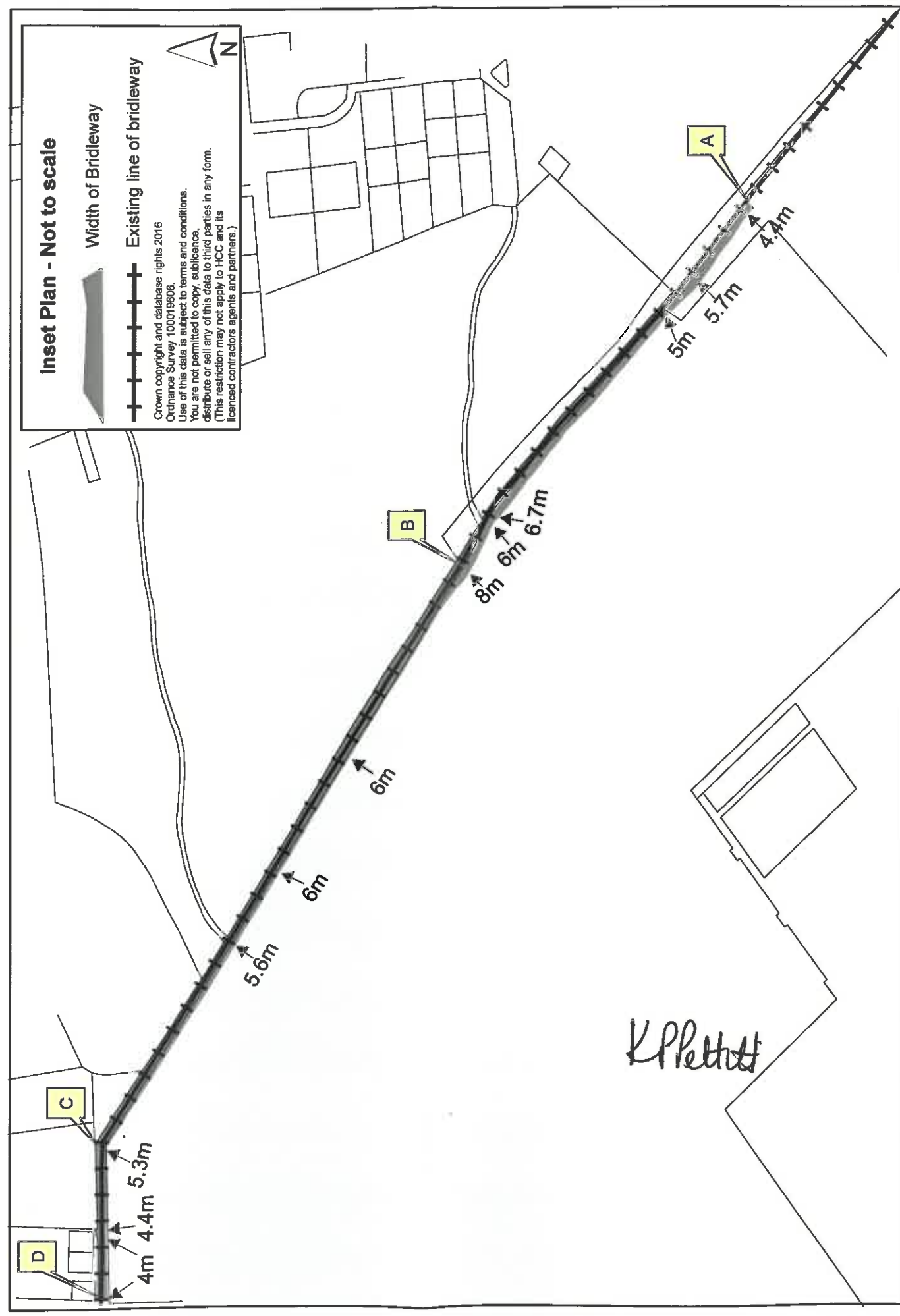
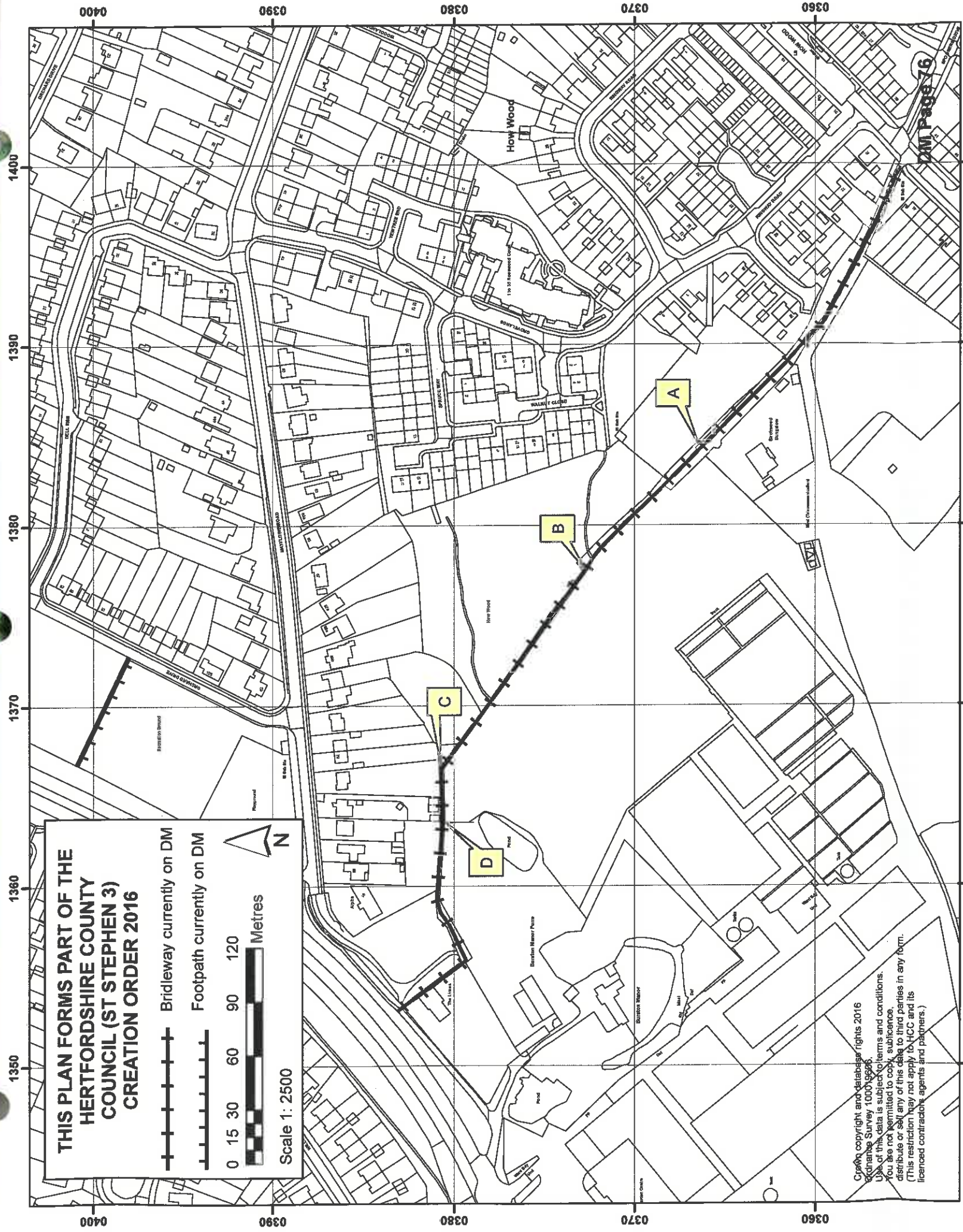
**SCHEDULE**

**PART 1**  
**DESCRIPTION OF LAND**

Additional width on the south west side of the public bridleway commencing at the bollards on St Stephen Bridleway 3 at TL 1385 0366 (Point A on the Order Plan) and running generally north west for approximately 230 metres to TL 1367 0381 (Point C on the Order Plan) then generally westwards for approximately 30 metres to TL 1363 0381 (Point D on the Order Plan).

Width: 4 metres at TL 1363 0381 (Point D on the Order Plan) widening to 8 metres at TL 1377 0373 (Point B on the Order Plan) narrowing to 4.4 metres at TL 1385 0366 (Point A on the Order Plan) as shown shaded grey on the Order Plan.
