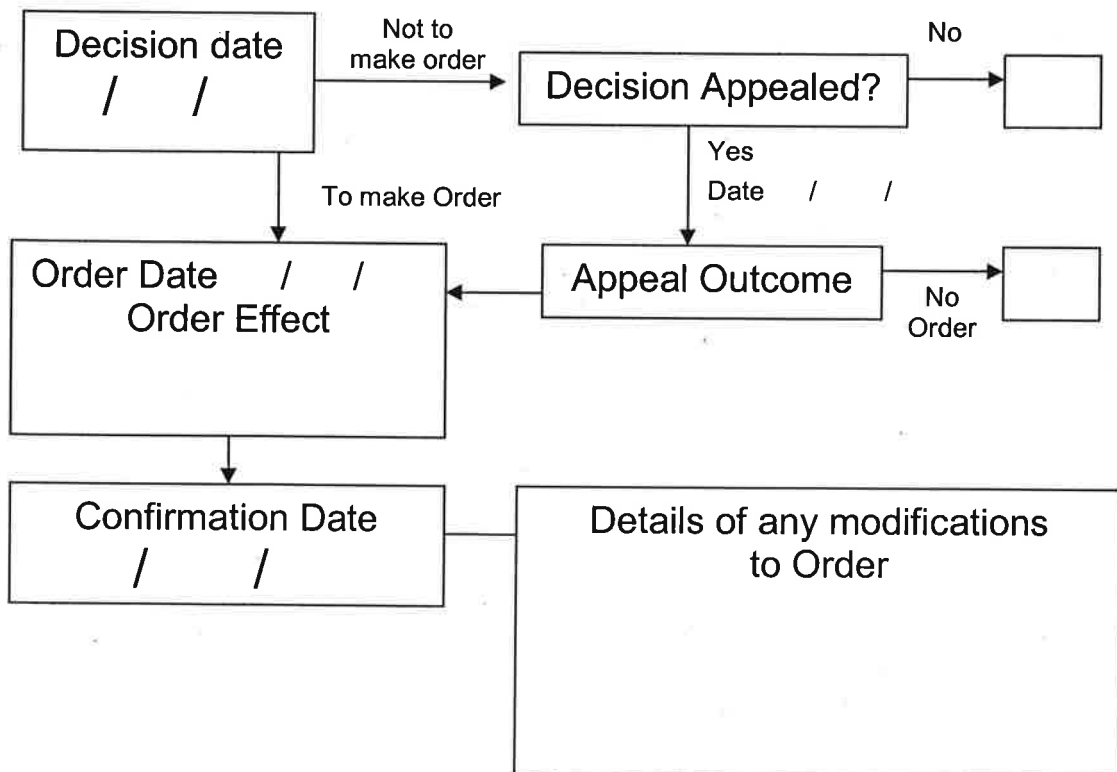

## Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

### The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Hertfordshire

I, Dr Philip David Wadey of Holland Farm, Aldenham, Hertfordshire hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:

adding the byway open to all traffic from the county road (Blunts Lane) (TL 1173 0446) opposite Footpath 43 St Stephen thence generally westnorthwestwards for a distance of approximately 200m and with a width of at least four metres to a junction with Footpath 36A St Stephens (TL 1156 0457), thence generally westnorthwestwards for a distance of approximately 280m with a width of at least four metres to the side of the M1 motorway (TL 1129 0465) and shown on the map accompanying this application.

I attach copies of the following documentary evidence (including statements of witnesses) in support of this application:

- Letter from Hertfordshire County Council indicating that the route is a county road.
- Copy of map from County Records Office, showing that the route was a county road in 1927.
- Extract from 'The Watford and South of St-Albans Redbourne ---Kidney Wood, Luton, Special Road (Improvements) Order 1958'.
- Statement of Evidence's Value (by the applicant).

A definitive map modification order will not create new rights but will just record those rights which already exist.

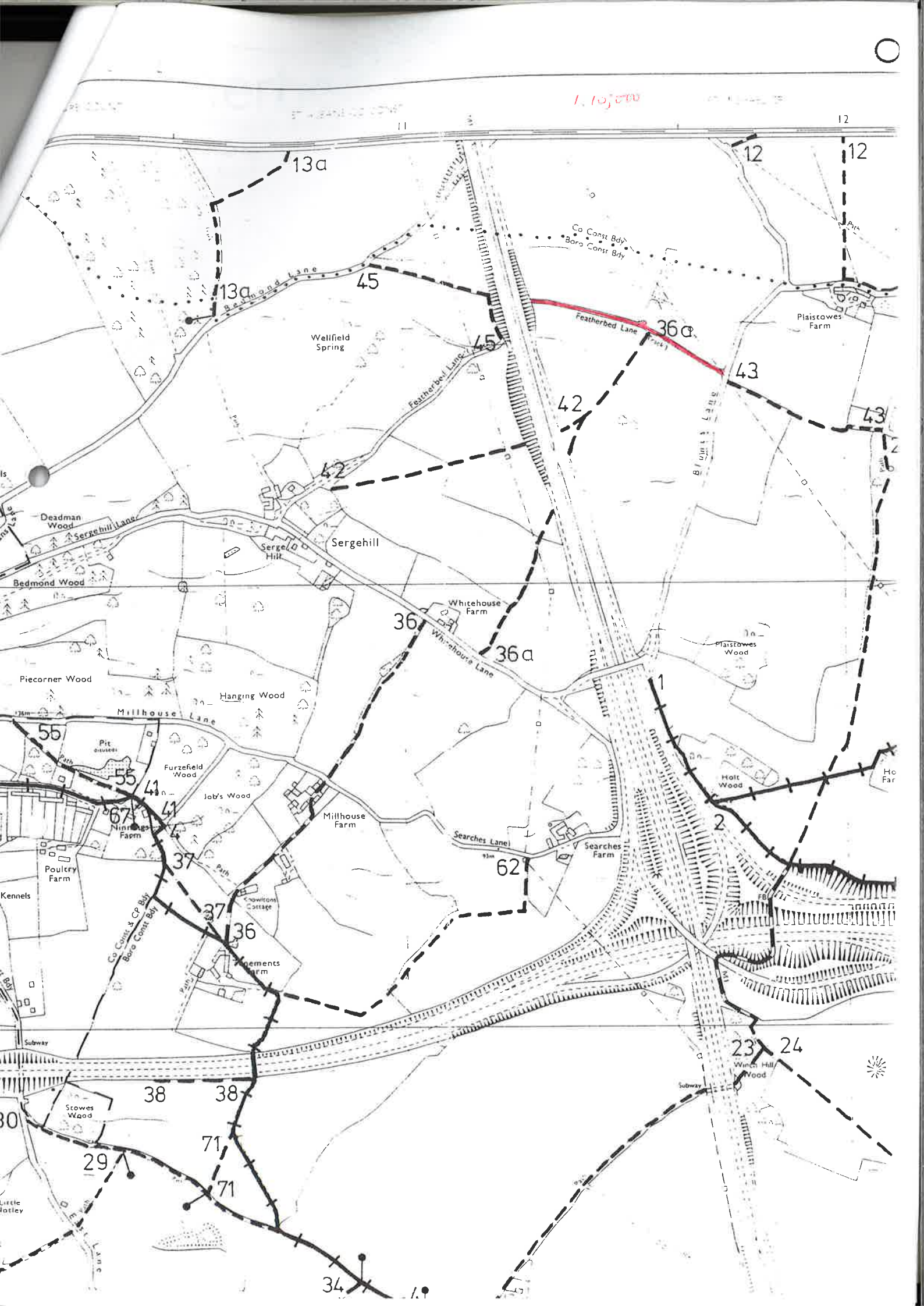
This application is made in order to assist the County Council to meet its statutory duty to record public rights of way.
