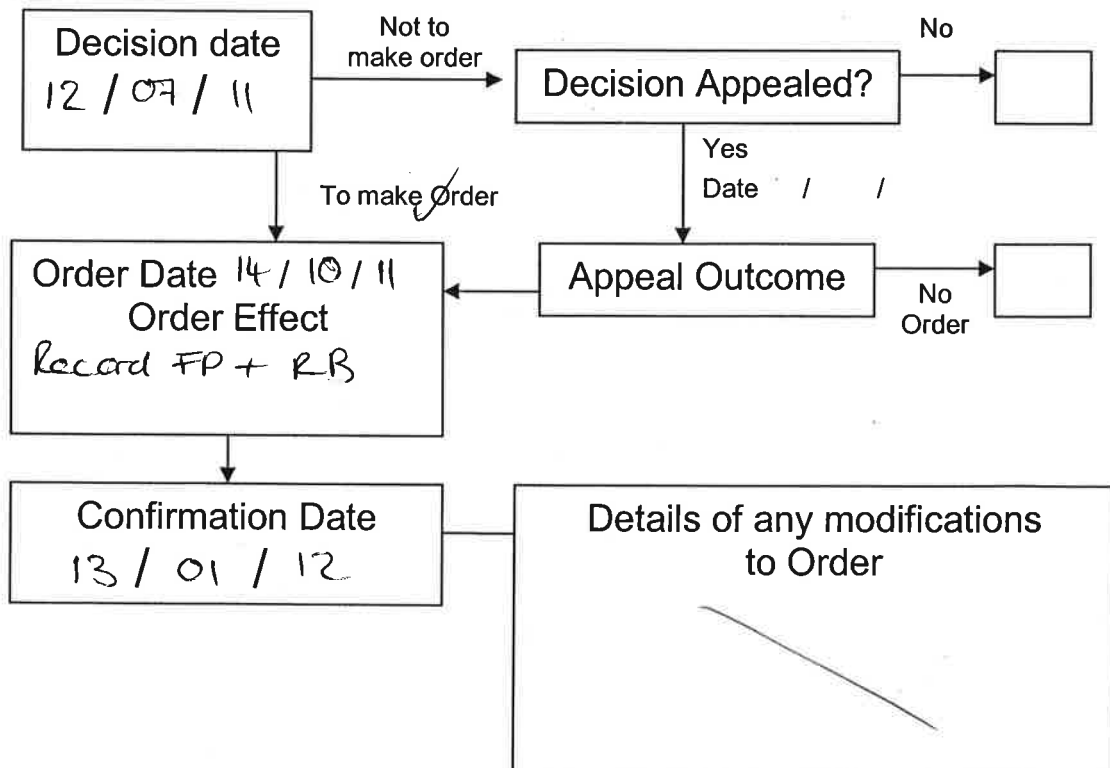

I, Dr Philip David Wadey of 12 Home Close, Corsham, Wiltshire SN13 0BE hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:

1. adding the footpath from metalled part of Hyde Lane (off Park Street Lane), over the railway land as defined in the British Railways Act 1966 to the restricted byway below, and
2. adding the restricted byway from the footpath above to Park Street.

and shown on the map accompanying this application.

I attach copies of the following documentary evidence (including statements of witnesses) in support of this application:

- Extract from Bryant's Map of Hertfordshire (1822) which shows the route in the manner of 'Lanes and Bridleways'
- Extract from the Watford Fieldpath Association map of 1902, which shows the route coloured ochre, the same as for other public vehicular highways
- Extract from a map entitled "Hertfordshire Main and County Roads" dated circa 1930, the original of which is in the Hertfordshire Archives and Local Studies office under reference Off Acc 732. This shows Hyde Lane as a county road, number 613, which means it carries vehicular rights.
- Extract from The British Railways Act 1966 (c. xvii). Section 13 of the Act stopped up rights other than those on foot of that section of the application route that formed the level crossing at Hyde Lane.
- Applicant's letter dated 26 Oct 07.

I am advised that the following evidence may be of value to this investigation, although I have not had sight of it myself:

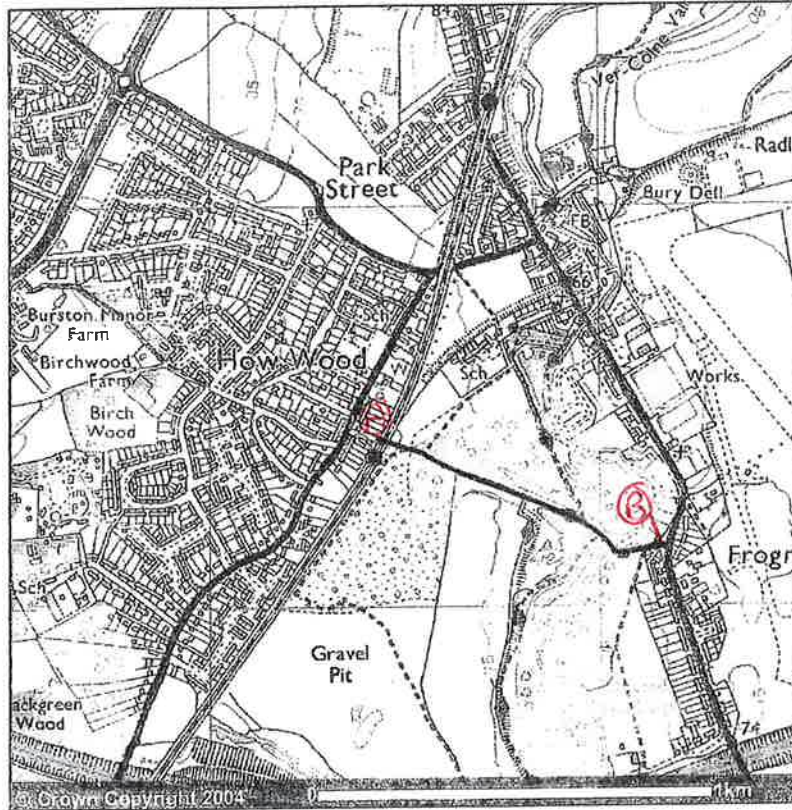
- The Rural District of St Albans (Main Roads) Order 1927, item 1134.
- Resolution of the Highways Committee of the County Council on 23 Feb 1931 relating to the adoption of the section from the level crossing to the River Ver.
- The taking over of roads from the rural district council on 1 Apr 1930 in accordance with the Local Government Act 1929.
