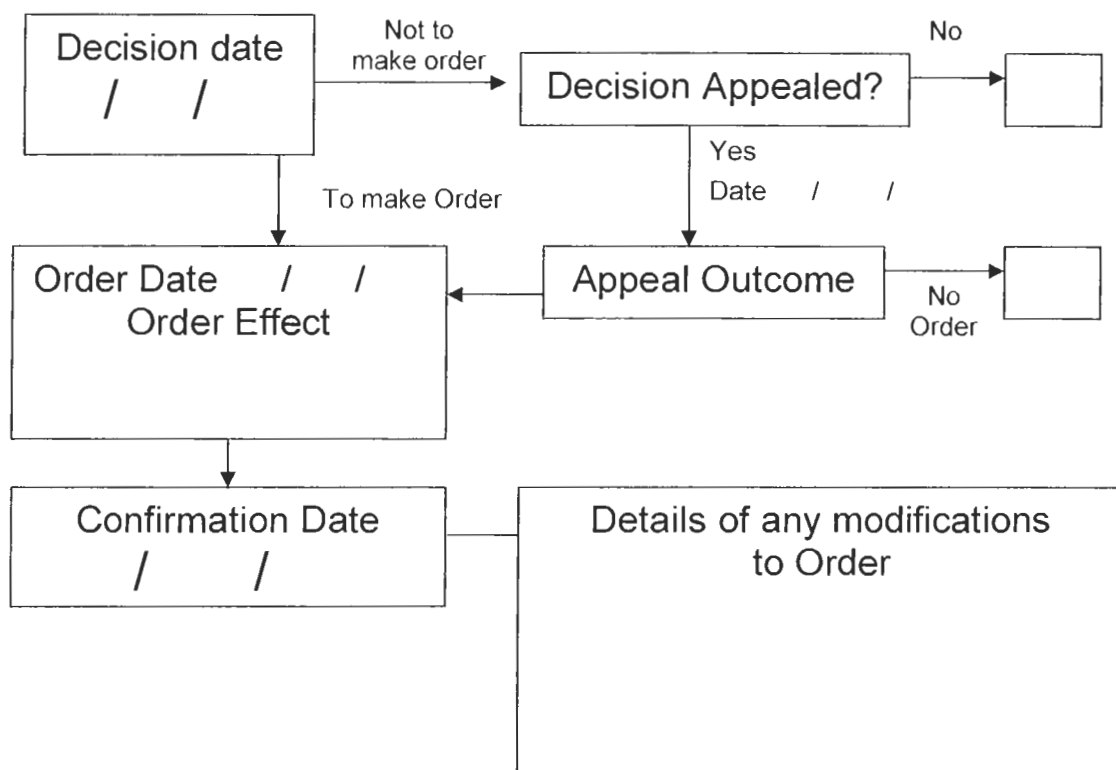

The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Hertfordshire is a record of rights of way in the County.

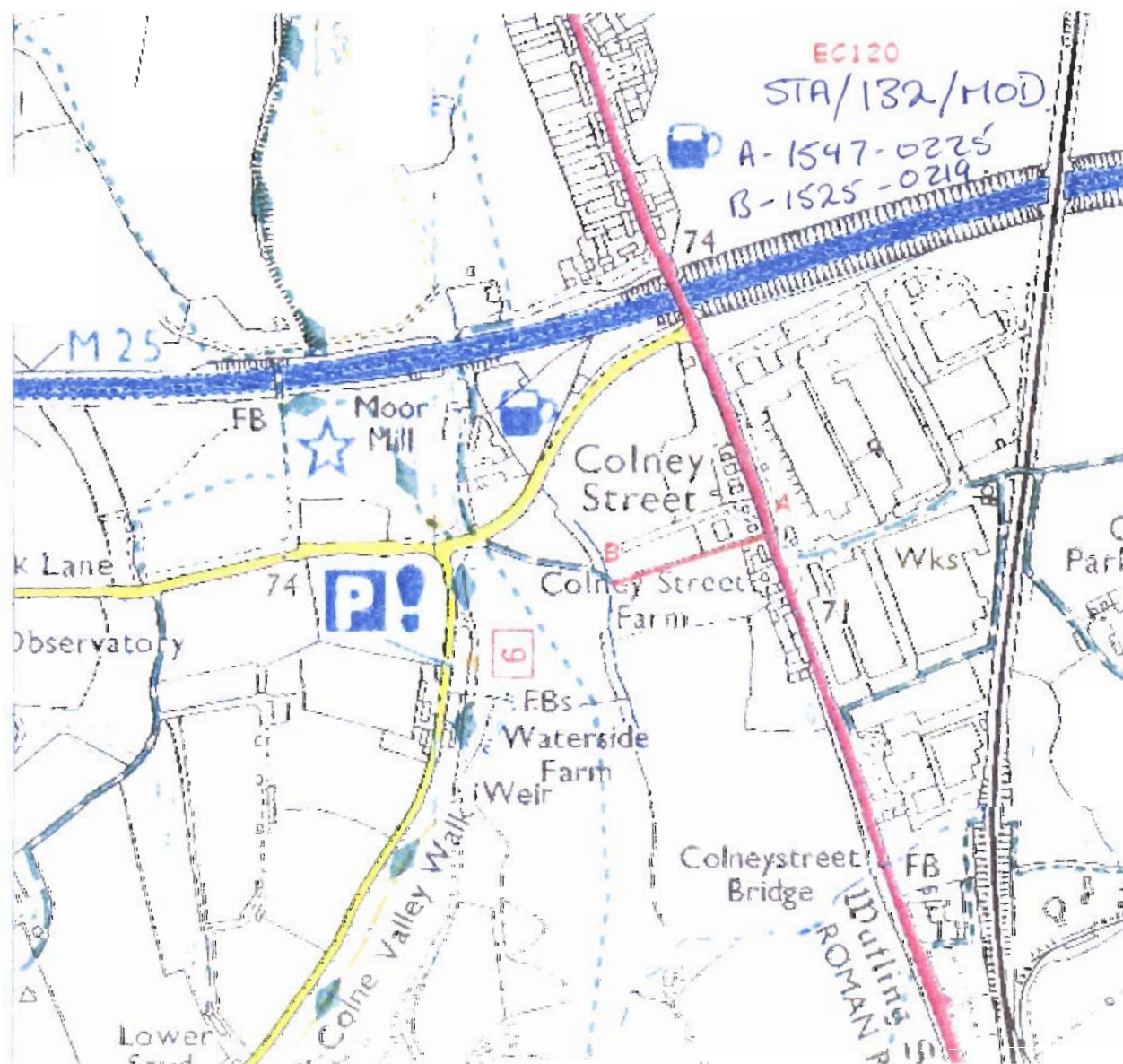
This application has been made because it appears that a public right of way exists which has not been recorded in the Definitive Map and Statement.

1. My name is Phil Wadey, and I have been the British Horse Society's regional access and bridleways officer for the East of England since 1996. I am the applicant for the order, on behalf of the Society.
2. The application route runs from the A5183 Colney Street (a county road) to the eastern end of St Stephen 6 (a bridleway on the definitive map). The application route is not currently shown on the definitive map of rights of way for Hertfordshire. It is shown from A (Colney Street) to B (St Stephen 6) below.

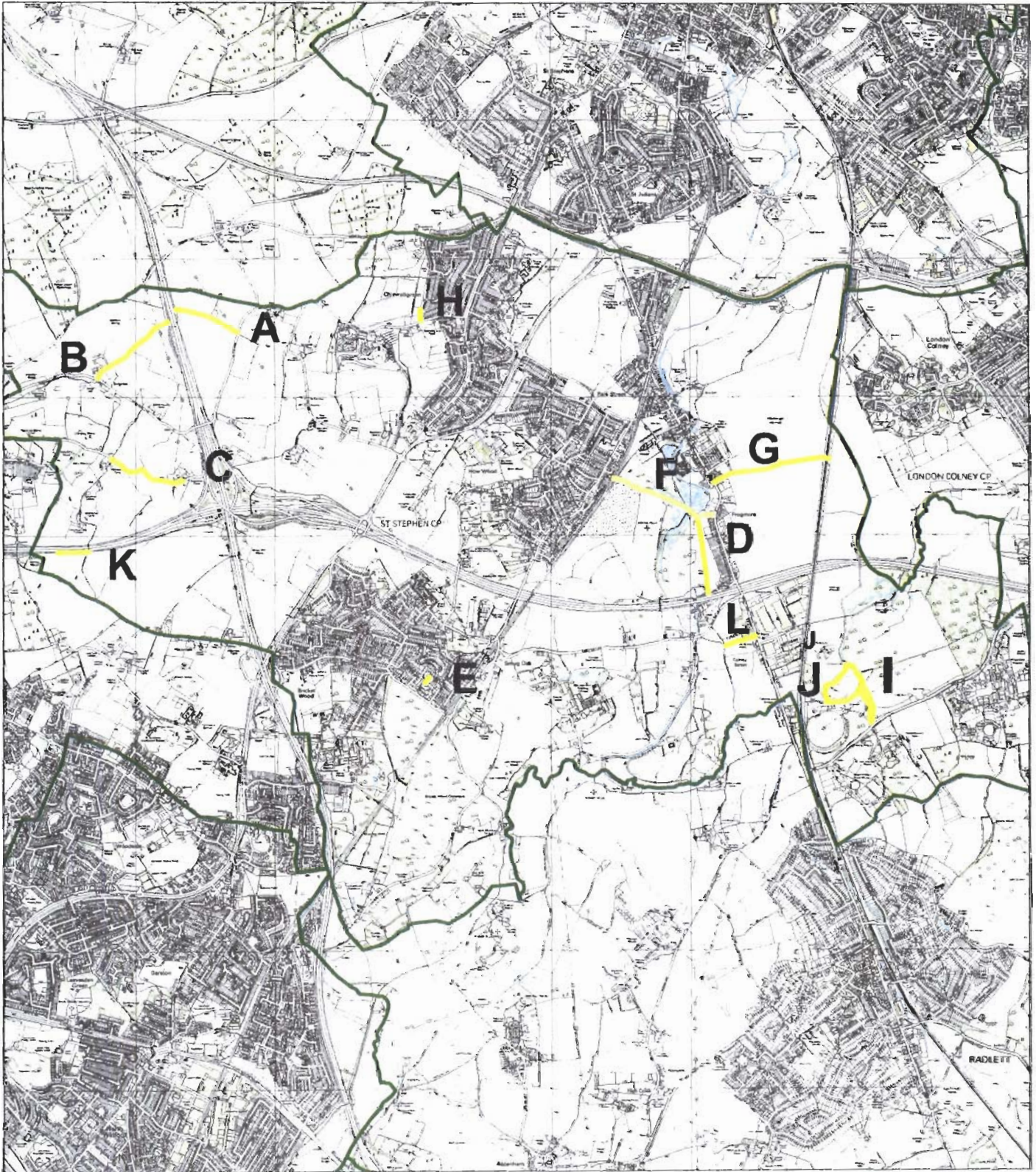


*Extract from OS Explorer (1:25,000 scale) Map of the Area*

### EVIDENCE OF HIGHWAY STATUS

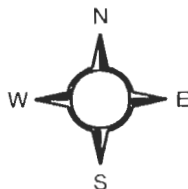
