OF MODIFICATION ORDER

**Hertfordshire County Council (Standon 72)  
Modification Order 2011**

The above named Order, made on 14th October 2011, was confirmed without modification by Hertfordshire County Council on 26th January 2012.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement by :-

downgrading to a Footpath that part of Standon Byway Open to All Traffic 72 running generally south from TL 4157 2144 for approximately 180 metres to TL 4151 2127

and

varying the particulars relating to Standon Byway Open to All Traffic 72 between TL 4157 2158 and TL 4157 2144 by recording a width varying from 2.5m to 11m as shown excluded from the hereditament on the Finance Act 1910 map.

A copy of the confirmed Order may be seen free of charge at Front Reception of Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford, from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday and can be bought from Hertfordshire County Council at a cost of £2. A copy of the confirmed Order and Notice may also be seen at East Herts District Council, Wallfields, Hertford

The Order becomes operative as from the date on which it was confirmed, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, or any regulation made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may, under paragraph 12 of Schedule 15 of the Act within 42 days from 2nd February 2012, make application for the purpose of the High Court.
