

NOTICE OF MAKING OF A DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

**HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (STANDON 91)
DIVERSION ORDER 2011**

The above Order was made on 26th January 2012, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. This order will divert the public footpath running from the entrance to St Edmund's College off Ermine Street at TL 3751 2175 and continuing in a generally north westerly direction to the junction with Old Hall Green Lane at TL 3700 2189, so that it runs instead from the junction with Ermine Street at TL 3748 2172 and continues in a generally north westerly direction across the meadow for approximately 215 metres to TL 3728 2179 then continues in a generally westerly direction along the brow of the hill for approximately 210 metres to TL 3707 2180 then in a generally north north westerly direction uphill for approximately 145 metres to a junction with Old Hall Green Lane at TL 3699 2192 as shown on the Order Plan.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Hertfordshire County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
