

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF A DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

**HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (Standon 90)
DIVERSION ORDER 2012**

On 11th September 2014, the Secretary of State for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs confirmed without modifications the above Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public bridleway running from TL 4017 2022 generally east for approximately 275 metres to TL 4045 2027 then generally south for approximately 440 metres to a junction with Standon Bridleway 49 and Standon Bridleway 50 at TL 4035 1984 to a line running from a junction with Standon Bridleway 90 at TL 4017 2022 generally south east for approximately 190 metres to TL 4030 2009 then generally south west following the headland for approximately 210 metres to a junction with the farm track at TL 4022 1990. Continuing generally south for approximately 25 metres then generally east for approximately 130 metres to a junction with Standon Bridleway 49 and Standon Bridleway 50 at TL 4035 1984 as shown on the Order Plan.

A copy of the order and the order plan may be seen free of charge at front reception of Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford, from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday and at East Herts District Council, Walfields, Hertford. Copies of the order and plan may be bought from Hertfordshire County Council at the price of £2.

The Order comes into force as from 9th October 2014, but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 9th October 2014, make an application to the High Court.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

This Order is made by Hertfordshire County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the bridleway described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Dunstable Lodge Limited and Chaldean Estates Ltd have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the way into a fit condition for use by the public.

St. Albans District Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

THIS ORDER

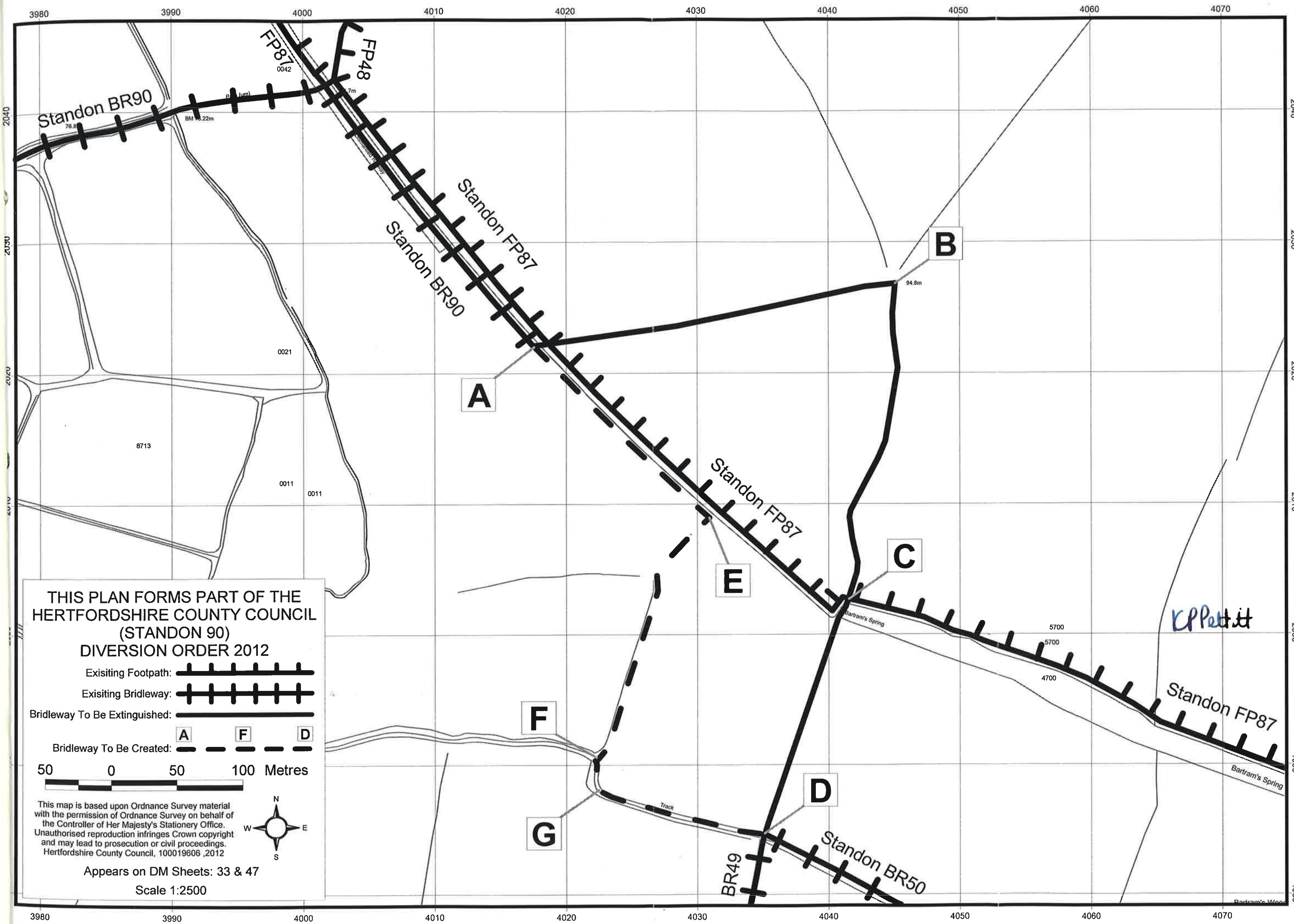
1. The public right of way over the land situate at Standon shown by a bold continuous line on the plan forming part of this Order ("the Order Plan") and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be stopped up after 21 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 21 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public bridleway over the land situate at Standon described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Order Plan attached to this Order.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

The full width of that part of Standon Bridleway 90 running from TL 4017 2022 (Point A on the Order Plan) in a generally easterly direction for approximately 275 metres to TL 4045 2027 (Point B on the Order Plan) continuing in a generally southerly direction for approximately 250 metres crossing Standon Footpath 87 at TL 4041 2002 (Point C on the Order Plan) then continuing in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 190 metres to a junction with Standon Bridleway 49 and Standon Bridleway 50 at TL 4035 1984 (Point D on the Order Plan).

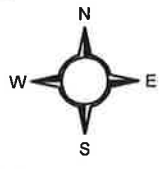

PART 2
DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A public Bridleway commencing at a junction with Standon Bridleway 90 at TL 4017 2022 (Point A on the Order Plan) running in a generally south easterly direction on the southern side of the hedge for approximately 190 metres to TL 4030 2009 (Point E on the Order Plan). Continuing in a generally south westerly direction following the headland for approximately 210 metres to a junction with the farm track at TL 4022 1990 (Point F on the Order Plan). Continuing in a generally southerly direction for approximately 25 metres to TL 4022 1988 (Point G on the Order Plan) then in a generally easterly direction for approximately 130 metres to a junction with Standon Bridleway 49 and Standon Bridleway 50 at TL 4035 1984 (Point D on the Order Plan).

Width: 4 metres between TL 4017 2022 (Point A on the Order Plan) and TL 4035 1984 (Point D on the Order Plan).
