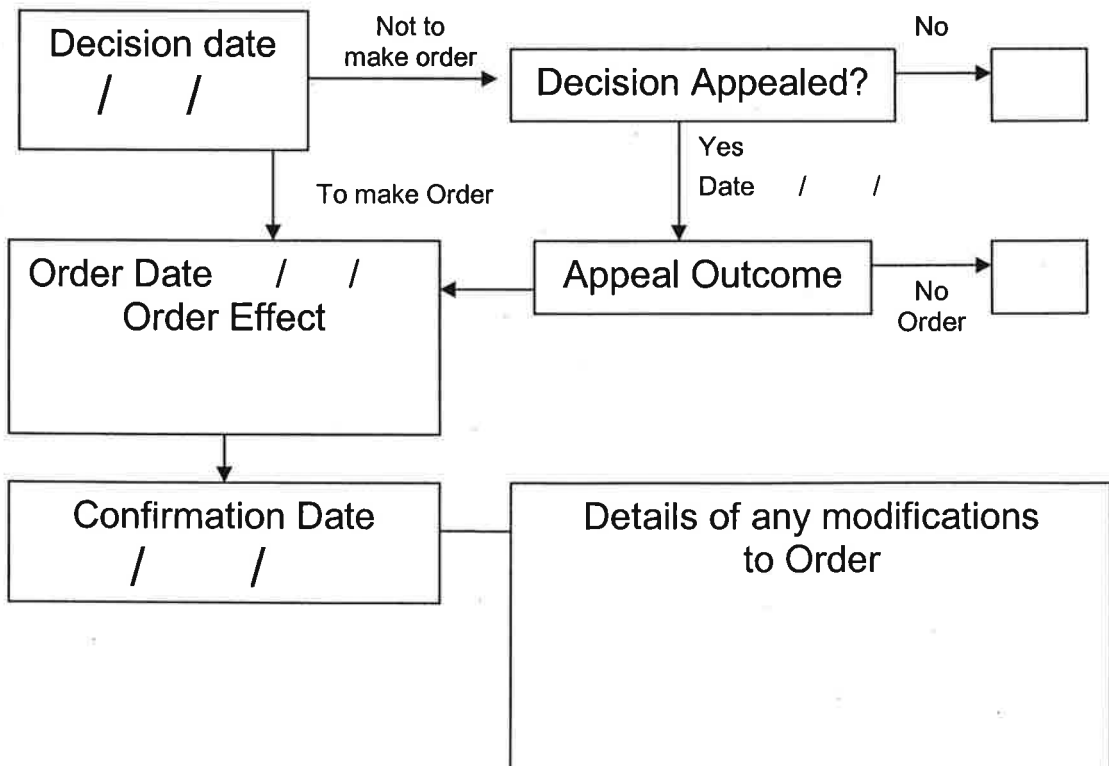

It also goes diagonally across the field to the rear entrance of the church and cottage remains of Thundridgebury. It crosses the river at the bathhouse, and then goes directly up to the top of Thundridge park and across to link up with the existing footpath at Youngsbury Drive. The Area around the moat was always recreational area, and wildlife as the moat was filled with water

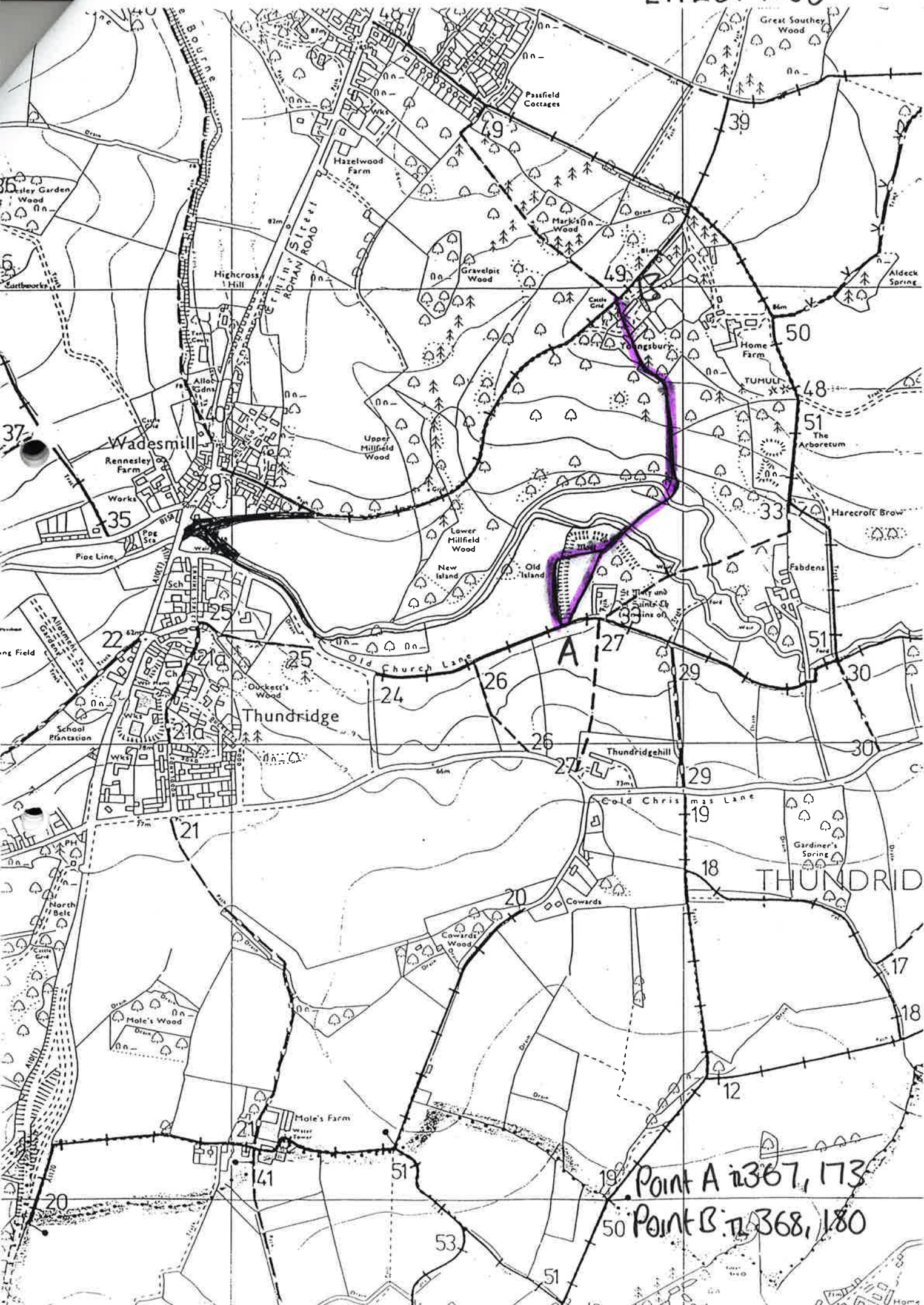
