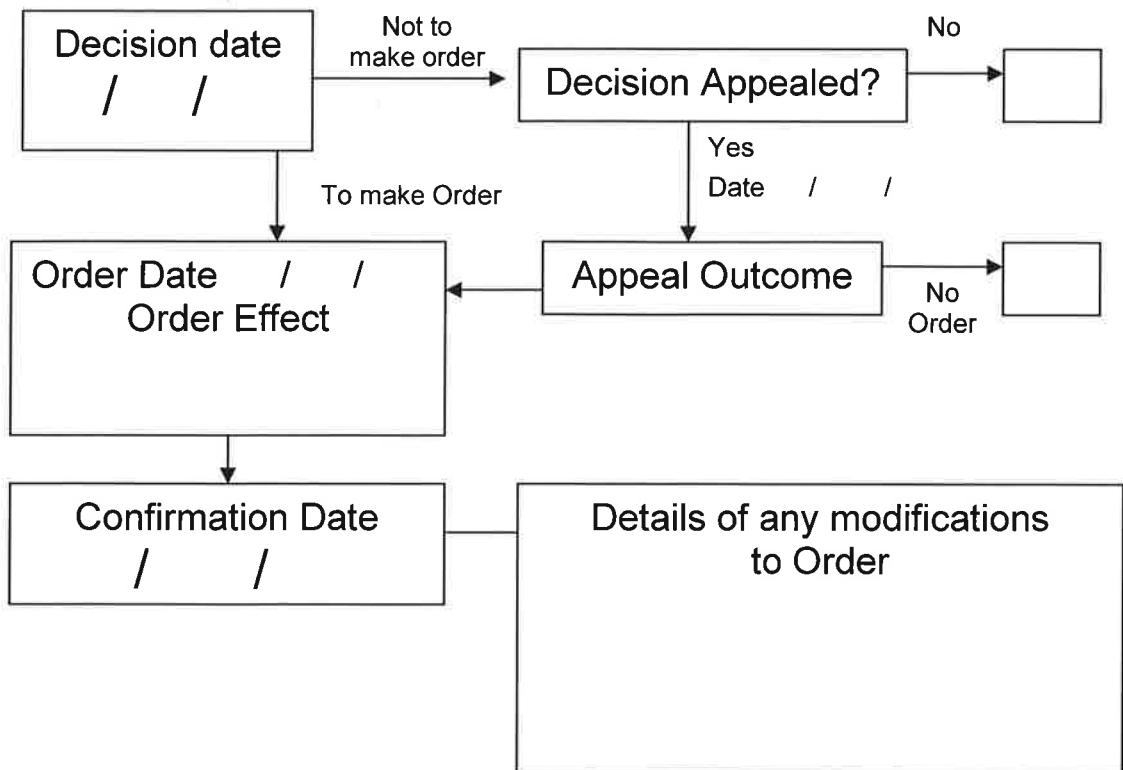

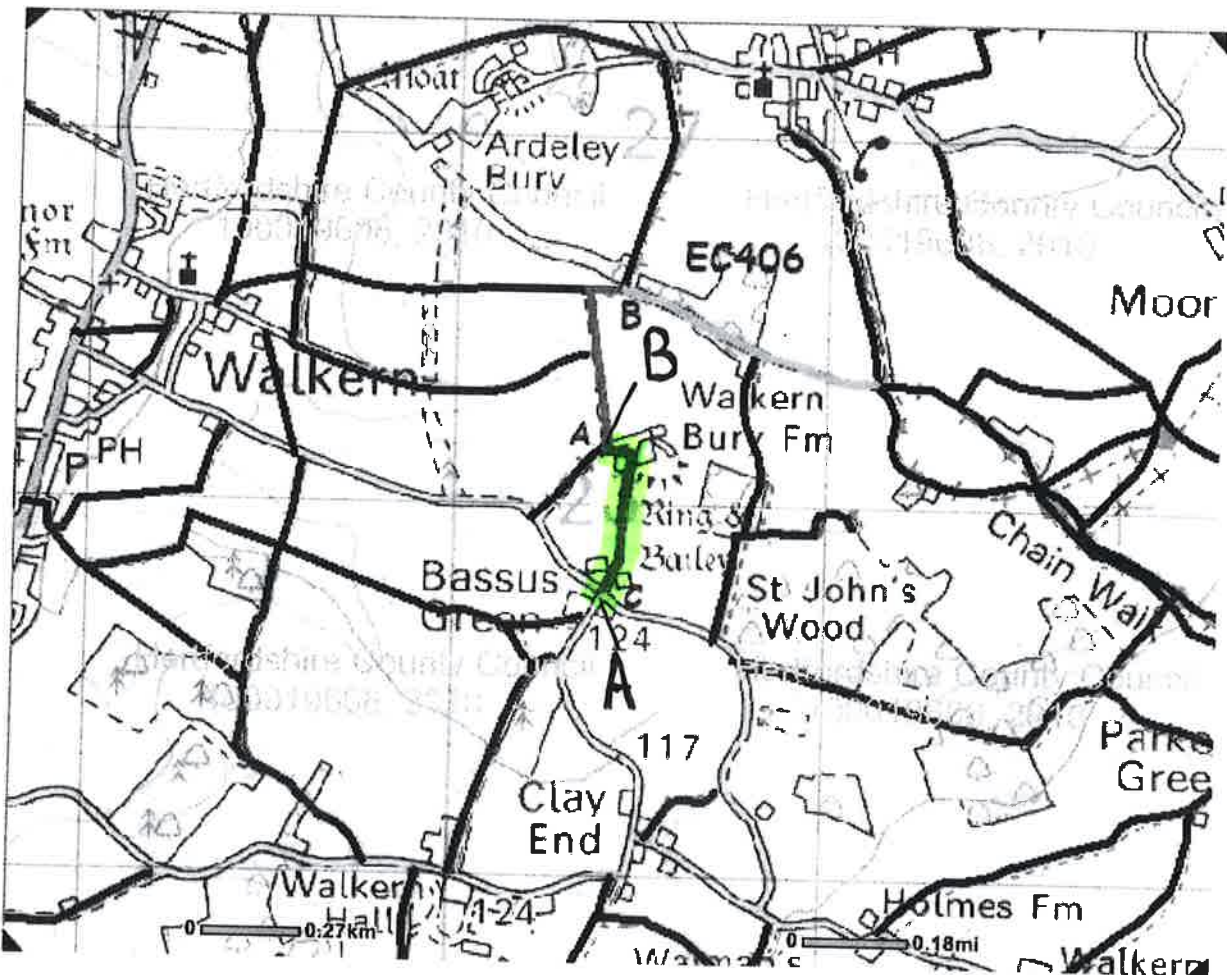

1. My name is Phil Wadey, and I have been the British Horse Society's regional access and bridleways officer for the East of England since 1996. I am the applicant for the order, on behalf of the Society.
2. The application route runs from the county road at Bassus Green (Point C on the plan below) generally northwards to Walkern Bury Farm, then generally westwards to a junction with Walkern 29 Byway (Point A). The application route is not currently shown on the definitive map of rights of way for Hertfordshire (sheet 23).

#### DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE OF HIGHWAY STATUS

3. In order to be able to modify the definitive map and statement, the Surveying Authority needs to have a discovery of evidence which shows, on the balance of probabilities, that highway rights exist.
4. While no single piece of evidence is conclusive, the Society believes that taken as a whole the pieces of evidence demonstrate highway reputation over many years, indicating that the route does indeed have highway status, and that prior to the Natural Environment and Rural Communities Act 2006, there were full vehicular rights.

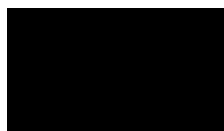
