

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF A DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

**HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WARESIDE 13)  
DIVERSION ORDER 2012**

On 9<sup>th</sup> June 2015, the Secretary of State for the Environment confirmed with modifications the above Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the footpath running from its junction with footpath 14 at TL 3915 1591 (Point A on the Order Plan) south east across a field for 320 metres to the public road at TL 3940 1573 (Point B on the Order Plan) and move it to a new line from the public road at TL 3940 1573 (Point B on the Order Plan) up footsteps and along headland in a generally westerly direction for 195 metres crossing footpath 15 at TL 3921 1570 (Point C on the order Plan) and continuing west for 25 metres to join footpath 14 at TL 3919 1569 (Point D on the Order Plan) as shown on the Order Plan.

A copy of the order and the order plan may be seen free of charge at front reception of Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford, from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday and at East Herts District Council, Wallfields, Pegs Lane, Hertford, SG13 8EQ. Copies of the order and plan may be bought from Hertfordshire County Council at the price of £2.

The Order comes into force as from 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2015, but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2015, make an application to the High Court.

**Hertfordshire County Council (Wareside 13) Diversion Order 2012**

East Hertfordshire District Council and Wareside Parish Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

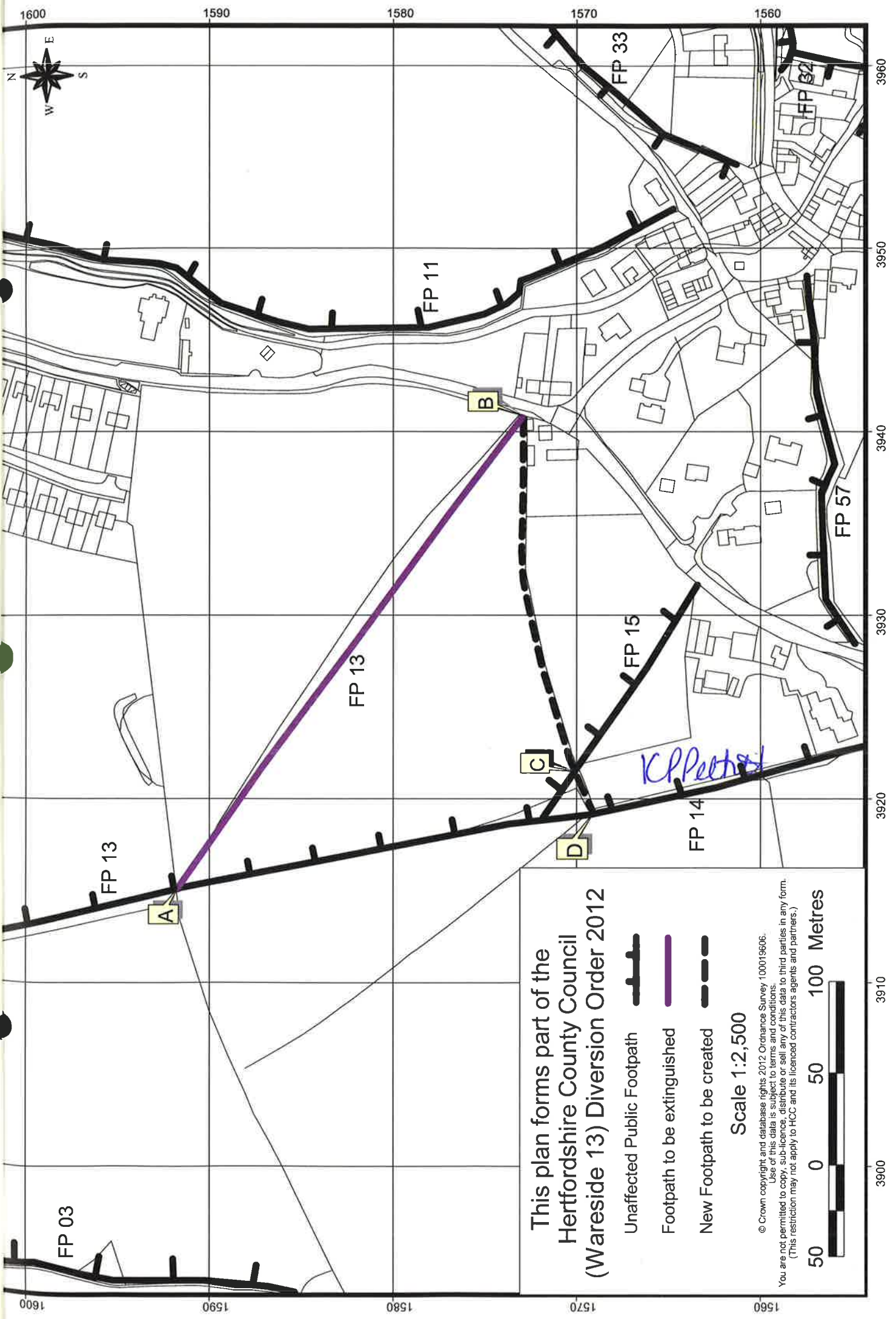
**BY THIS ORDER**

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Wareside shown by a bold continuous line on the plan forming part of this Order ("the Order Plan") and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall on the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Wareside described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Order Plan.

**SCHEDULE**

**PART 1**  
**DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY**

The full width of that part of footpath 13 from its junction with footpath 14 at TL 3915 1591 (Point A on the Order Plan) continuing in a generally south easterly direction across a field for approximately 320 metres to the public road at TL 3940 1573 (Point B on the Order Plan).

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

Footpath from its junction with the public road at TL 3940 1573 (Point B on the Order Plan) continuing up footsteps and along headland on the north side of the boundary in a generally westerly direction for approximately 195 metres crossing footpath 15 at TL 3921 1570 (Point C on the Order Plan) and continuing in a generally westerly direction for approximately 25 metres ~~over footbridge~~ to join footpath 14 at TL 3919 1569 (Point D on the Order Plan).
