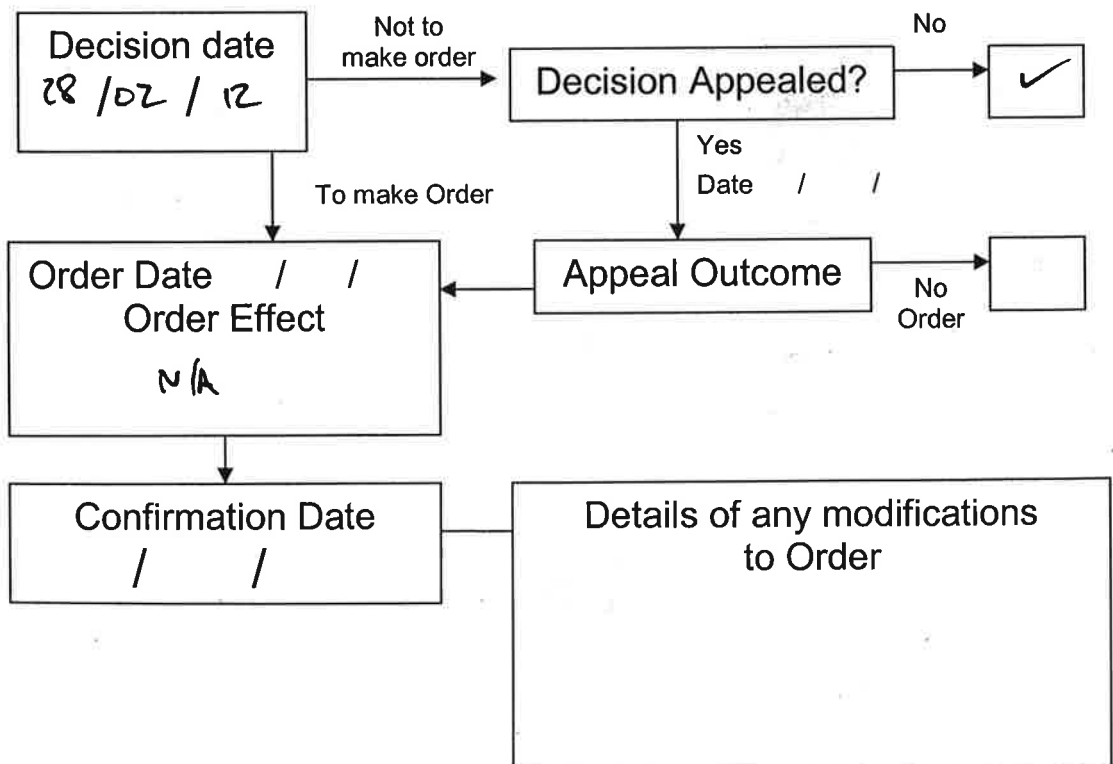

I, the Clerk, for and on behalf of Wigginton Parish Council c/o Poynings, Northchurch Common, Berkhamsted, Hertfordshire, HP4 1LR, hereby give notice that on 12th August 1999 I made application to Hertfordshire County Council of County Hall, Hertford, SG13 8DN that the Definitive Map and Statement for the area should be modified by:-

- Adding a byway open to all traffic along the track leading between the two arms of Hemp Lane, Wigginton (SP 9409, 1030), parallel to the boundary of The Old School Master's House and above the grassed area.
