



### **DECISION NOTICE**

An application dated 5<sup>th</sup> December 2011 was made under Section 15 (1) to the Commons Act 2006 by Save Your Berkhamsted Residents Association. The application was made to register land as a Town or Village Green under Section 15 (3).

A public inquiry was held on 25th March 2014 at Berkhamsted Civic Centre.

The Inspector, appointed by the Planning Inspectorate, considered whether:

- a significant number of the inhabitants of any locality, or of any neighbourhood within a locality, have indulged as of right in lawful sports and pastimes on the land for a period of at least 20 years;
- they ceased to do so before the time of the application but after the coming into operation of section 15
- the application was made within the period of two years beginning with the cessation of use

The Inspector was not satisfied that the test in section 15 of the 2006 Act in relation to the issue of neighbourhood is met.

#### The application is refused.
