SECTION 31 - THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

- 1. I am directed to deposit with you, under the provisions of Sub-Section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980 the enclosed plan/plans numbered Harts 31 of the Ministry of Defence Establishments within your area, and more particularly known as the A.F. M.G.:

 respectively upon which have been marked all the ways which the Secretary of State for Defence admits have been dedicated as highways. Will you please acknowledge safe receipt of the plans.
- 2. Your attention is particularly drawn to the legend on the plan, and I am to confirm that the extent of public rights recognised by the Secretary of State for Defence over each route shown on the plan is as follows:
 - (a) Over each route shown by continuous pumple line, the Secretary of State recognises a highway over which the public have a right of way on foot only.
 - (b) Over each route shown by a continuous green line, the Secretary of State recognises that the public have the following, but no other, rights of way, that is to say, a right of way on foot and a right of way on horseback or leading a horse, with or without a right to drive animals of any description along the highway.
 - (c) Over each route shown by a broken green line, the Secretary of State recognises the way to be a highway other than a footpath or bridleway used by the public mainly for the purposes for which footpaths or bridleways are so used, or as a byway open to all traffic.
 - (d) Over each route shown by a continuous brown tint the Secretary of State recognises the route as a public road over which the public has the right to pass for all purposes with or without animals or vehicles.

Of the above highways, those described in sub-paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) are more particularly described in the definitive statement prepared by the County Council under the provision of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949, as amended by the Countryside Act 1968. The routes indicated by paragraph (d) are more particularly described in detail on the Plan No. Help 31 attacked.

Statutory Declarations will continue to be lodged with you from time to time as required.





HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 Section 31(6)

- I, GEORGE WILLIAM KERNAGHAN, Defence Land Agent London, for and on behalf of the SECRETARY OF STATE FOR DEFENCE, and acting under the authority conferred upon me by the said Secretary of State **DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE** as follows:
- 1. The Secretary of State for Defence on the 27th day of March 1974 & the 20th day of February 1978 in accordance with Section 34(6) of the Highways Act 1959 caused to be deposited with Hertfordshire County Council maps numbered 77/74 & 77A/74 of a certain Establishment vested in the Secretary of State within the area administered by such Council together with a statement indicating what ways over that land were admitted by the Secretary of State to have been dedicated as highways.
- 2. In accordance with Section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980 no additional way over the land delineated on the map so deposited with Hertfordshire County Council which is still vested in the Secretary of State as shown by red edging on the attached map numbered 77B/74 has been dedicated as a highway since 20th February 1978 being the date of a previous Declaration in accordance with the said section of the 1959 Act.
