- 1 We, Andrew David Collins and Susan Frances Collins are the owners of the land described in paragraph 4 of Part A of this form and shown edged red on the map accompanying this declaration.
- 2 On the 11th day of May 2010 we Andrew David Collins and Susan Frances Collins deposited with Hertfordshire County Council, being the appropriate council, a statement accompanied by a map showing our property edged red which stated that:

the way shown coloured brown with a continuous line with alternate arrowheads had been dedicated as a byway open to all traffic

the ways shown coloured purple had been dedicated as footpaths

no other ways had been dedicated as highways over our property.

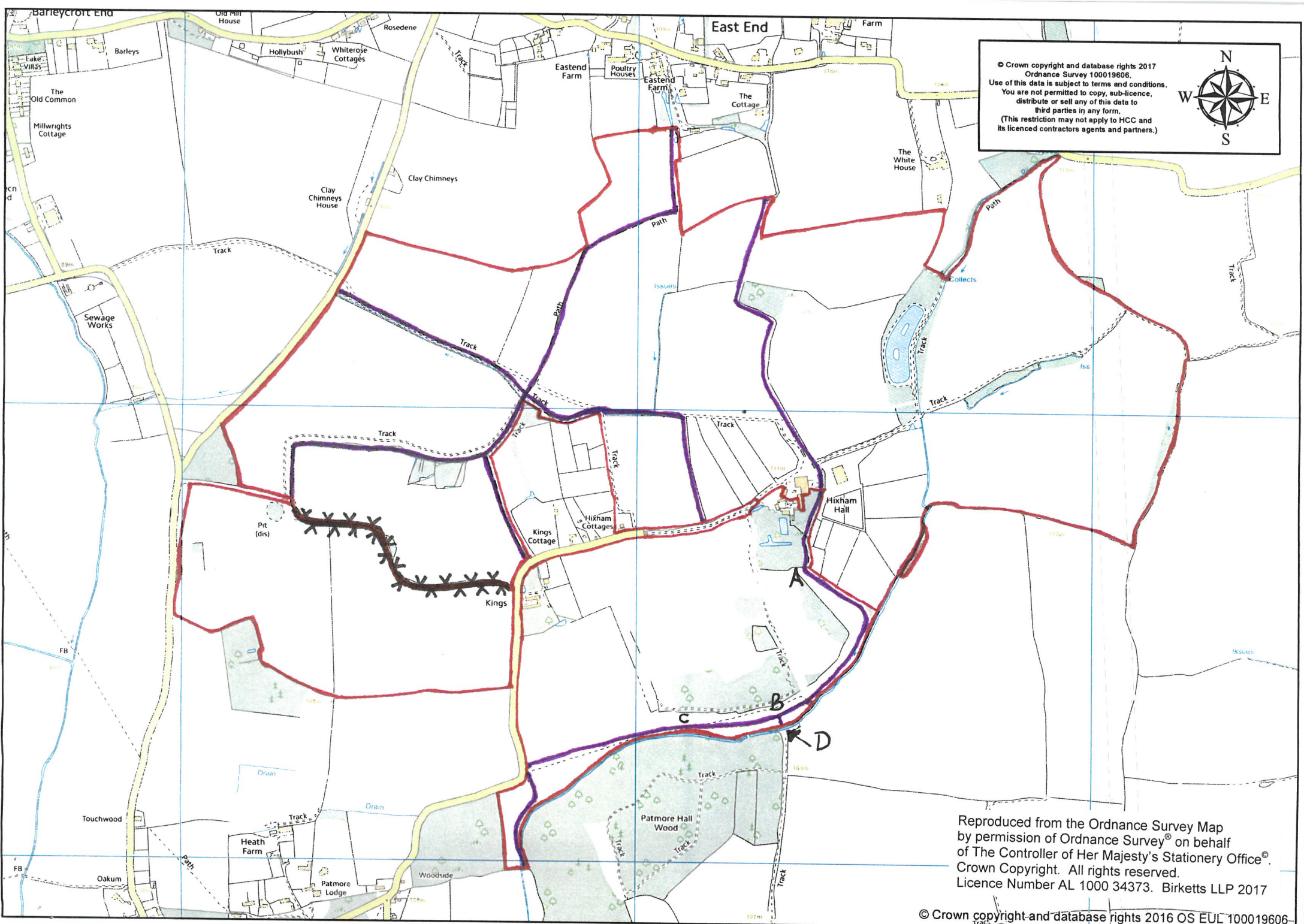
Fair Processing Notice
