FOOTPATH MAP. ETC

I refer to Section 34.6. on the Highways Act 1959. Under this, owners of land can deposit with District Councils a 6 inch map, and a statement as to the ways admitted to have been dedicated to the public. This will be sufficient evidence to negative the owners intentions to dedicate any additional ways.

I act for the Trustees of the Settlement, who own areas of land at Gaddesden Row, largely Southings Farm and 6 Tunnels Field.

These areas are shown on the attached map edged and hatched in red. The map is a copy of the statutory footpath map, and the ways admitted are as shown on that map.

I hereby deposit this map, and will you confirm that it is satisfactory for your purposes under the Highways Act as referred to above.
